

Dear "Speak Out" Are you a survivor?

One of the most popular reality television shows is Survivor! People often wonder if they could survive the treacherous and challenging conditions enduring all kinds of trials in an effort to win one million dollars. The individual contestants get to decide how much they are willing to endure to win.

What Americans don't seem to recognize, acknowledge or appreciate, is that there are millions of 'real' survivors who are alive today living in this country who escaped a tortuous and brutal death from the hands of calculating diabolical killers. These survivors haven't won a million dollars, but they have won the right to live and breathe because of a decision their mother made. Let me explain. So, if you were born after January 22, 1973 smile, you are an abortion SURVIVOR! Congratulations!



STI AWARENESS MONTH

Nearly 20 million new sexually transmitted infections occur in the United States every year, costing the American healthcare system approximately \$16 billion in direct medical costs alone, according to the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). America's youth shoulder a substantial burden of these infections. CDC estimates that half of all new STIs in the country occur among young men and women aged 15 to 24.

Chlamydia is the most common STI in the United States. In 2017, 143 chlamydia cases, 10 gonorrhea cases and 2 syphilis cases were reported in Livingston County. The majority of the cases were among young adults.

The high incidence of STIs in the general population suggests that many Americans are at risk of exposure to these infections, underscoring the need for prevention. Despite this news, there are effective ways to prevent, diagnose, and treat STIs. Abstaining from sex, reducing the number of sexual partners, and consistently and correctly using condoms are all effective prevention strategies. Safe, effective vaccines are also available to prevent hepatitis B and some types of the human papillomavirus (HPV) that can cause some types of cancer. For those who are sexually active - particularly young people - STI screening and prompt treatment (if infected) are critical to protect a person's health and prevent transmission to others. STI screenings and early diagnoses are essential in preventing transmission and the long term health consequences of STIs.

The Livingston County Department of Health in observance of STI Awareness Month would like to encourage everyone to be tested for STIs. Knowledge is power! Once you know if you have an STI, you can make important decisions about your health and well-being. Men, women, and teens can receive confidential, low or no cost STI testing at the Livingston County Reproductive Health Center.
