THERE IS A HERO AMONG US!

Every year the New York State Outdoorsmen Hall of Fame selects individuals who have been nominated by fellow outdoorsmen for their many years of preserving our outdoor heritage, working for conservation and enhancing our outdoor sports for future generations. This year eleven individuals from across the state have been inducted including one of our own Orleans County residents.

Neil Newton of Albion has been past president and a member of the Finger Lakes

Conservation Council for 35 years. He has been active in the St. Mary's Archers Club, Black North Rod and Gun Club and the Orleans County Federation of Sportsmen for 63 years. He has also been a hunter safety instructor and served on the hunter education committee of the New York State Conservation Council for many years. Neil was a co-founder of the DEC walleye cooperator rearing project and made arrangements necessary for the project and was involved with the rearing and stocking of walleye fingerlings. All this conservation activity over many years was done with his free time often traveling great distances across the state at his own expense. The sportsmen of Orleans County owe Neil a lot of respect for all he has accomplished for them.

Neil and the other ten inductees will be honored at the annual banquet Sat., April 28, at Theodore's Restaurant in Canastota, N.Y.

As I write this, we have just finished up a whole day of extremely high winds which have not been good for our eagle nests. I waited until the last hour of daylight to check on the nest at the N.Y.S. Oak Orchard Wildlife Management area. This year they built a new nest in their original nest tree but at the top of the 90-foot white pine tree. They had a bad time of it last year when they produced no eaglets for some unknown reason.

Here's their history: Back in 2002 they built their first nest in a white pine tree on an island on Windmill Marsh. Here they were successful at raising one or two eaglets every year until 2008 and 2009, but then got back on track again. One year they built a new nest on the other end of the island and were successful, but returned to the original nest for the next few years and then took over a huge osprey nest nearby. There they were successful there each year until last year when a winter storm took the dead nest tree down. They quickly started a new nest 40 yards off the dike roadway between Campbell and Windmill marshes. The DEC quickly closed the roadway off to hikers and special permit holders as not to disturb the birds. However, another wind storm hit and that nest went down before any eggs were laid. They then went to that alternate nest they had on the island in Windmill and laid eggs. However, something went wrong and after the 35-day incubation period nothing appeared and the birds shortly abandoned the nest.

This new nest on the top of that 90-foot pine got to be a huge and I was concerned about its safety if we got high winds. Incubation started about Feb. 26 with a expected

Every time we had a windstorm the nest was checked, but it seemed to be holding up. Then tonight I went back to check and noticed right off that not all the nest was there. There was a eagle on the edge of what was left, but she wasn't incubating which she would have been doing even though the eggs had hatched. The young are very small and still need the mother's incubation that first week or so. I watched for about 45 minutes, until dark, but she never went to incubating on the remaining base of the nest which told me the young had been killed when the nest got torn apart by the wind.

The nest at the Tonawanda WMA never got going for some reason. They worked on it this spring, but no egg laying took place and in the last week or so no eagles have been seen in that area. It is possible that something happened to one of the eagles or maybe they have an alternate nest we don't know about.

I checked the nest up by the Lake Ontario and it seemed OK, but could not see a bird on the nest due to the wind shaking the van and scope so much.

The nest on the Iroquois NWR on Ringneck Marsh was still up, but no birds have been around it for the last week. I believe there has just been too much people traffic (ice fishing earlier and now hiking, photographers and shore fishing) on the dike going toward the nest

I haven't checked the eagle nest on the INWR in Cayuga Pool or the one north of Medina but hopefully they have survived this windstorm.

Save-the-Date Card Etiquette

fore and more couples planning to walk down the aisle are mbracing save-the-date cards to give guests adequate notice hat there is a party on the horizon.

ave-the-date cards do more than let guests know when ou're getting hitched. The cards are a preliminary way to eep guests informed and let them know they are, in fact, on ne guest list. These cards haven't always been so popular, but ave risen in popularity due to longer engagement periods, growing number of destination weddings and the growing umber of couples with guests from all over the country, if ot the world. Considering people often plan business trips, acations and other excursions several months in advance, ave-the-date cards help secure a greater number of attendees your wedding.

ave-the-date announcements can vary in many ways. hey may be postcards or magnets that can be attached to refrigerator door. If you desire a cohesive theme to your vedding stationery, select the save-the-date cards at the same me you choose your wedding invitations. This way you an ensure that either the patterns, fonts, colors, or style of he cards will match. It will also help convey the tone of the vedding. Guests often take their cues regarding the level of ormality of the wedding from the type of stationery couples hoose.

When to send out the save-the-date announcements is nportant as well. As a general rule of thumb, it is wise o mail out the cards 6 months in advance for a standard redding. If the wedding requires travel or extended overnight ccommodations, you may want to mail them out 8 months to year in advance to give guests the time to investigate flight osts and hotel arrangements. A wedding also may necessitate lanning a vacation or personal time off from work. Therefore, ample advanced notice is advisable.

Be sure to make your guest list in advance of sending out save-the-date cards. Everyone who receives a card should also be sent an invitation prior to the wedding. Remember to include any members of your planned wedding party in the list of recipients. Just because a person has verbally confirmed attendance at your wedding doesn't mean they should be excluded from subsequent announcements. Guests may talk to one another and it is best to avoid hurt feelings and any added drama before the wedding by treating everyone equally. Be sure to include the wedding date, your names and the location of the wedding on the save-the-date cards. You do not need to offer RSVP information or detailed specifics at this time. You may want to include a Web site URL on the card so guests can check it frequently for updates on wedding information. Be sure to also include that a formal invitation will follow at a later date. You do not want to cause confusion • by having guests think that the save-the-date card is the actual invitation. Also, make sure you address the save-the-date cards correctly to show your intentions with respect to guest invites. For example, be clear about whether children will be

Snack on Something Healthy

Healthy snacks are a great way to quell hunger pangs without feeling guilty. The following "Cauliflower recipe for Popcorn" from Bob Blumer's "Surreal Gourmet Bites" (Chronicle Books) is a sweet-tasting alternative to unhealthy snacks.

Cauliflower **Popcorn**

Yields 12 bites

1 head cauliflower 4 tablespoons olive oil 1 tablespoon salt (or, for a salt-free alternative, Mrs. Dash table blend)

Preheat oven to 425 F.

Cut out and discard cauliflower core and thick ! stems. Trim remaining cauliflower into florets the 1 size of golf balls. In a large bowl, add cauliflower, olive oil and salt. Toss thoroughly.

Spread cauliflower on a baking sheet (line with parchment paper, if available, for easy cleanup). Roast for 1 hour, or until much of the floret ! has become golden brown. (That's the caramelization process converting the dormant natural sugars into sweetness. The i browner the florets, the sweeter they will taste.) Turn 3 or 4 times during
