
Signs of the Past, Now

The sophomore averaged a nation-leading 9.4 assists per contest during the year after playing in the first 19 games of the season.





I don't have the money to pay for surgery that I need because of a wreck that wasn't my fault. Why won't the other person's insurance company go ahead and pay for me to get the surgery I need?

Joseph, Tuscumbia

The other person's insurance company does not want you to have surgery. If you do have surgery, it's to their advantage to delay your surgery so that they can argue that you did other things between the accident and the surgery to cause

You may be in a state of disbelief because you know for a fact that the accident caused the injury. They don't care. What you believe with all your heart is not evidence. No judge would let you testify that

because of this wreck you need surgery. Without a doctor to say so, you have no evidence that it's true and your belief is legally not worth anything. There is no sugar coating the fact that people confuse things they believe are apparent are doubted by insurance companies who make money by not paying claims.

I hate to say that that's why you need a lawyer, but it is, because what you see as absolute truth has to be put in a form that a jury can hear. You'll probably never have to go in front of a jury and no one should ever want to. However, insurance companies are going to make people try cases from time to time to make sure that the values of settlements are lower than going to court and because some people won't go to court.

All that being said, either have the surgery or hire a lawyer to get a statement from the doctor that's admissible about what the surgery will cost. A jury will award you the future costs of that surgery as well as pain and suffering that you have gone through because of the accident. A good medical record, which most people never get to see, that indicates a need for surgery shortly after the accident is invaluable. Remember, just because you told the doctor doesn't mean they wrote it down.

Get Free Help with Your Federal Taxes

Tax Day is nearly upon us! Have you filed your 2017 tax returns yet?

This year's tax due date is April 17, 2018, only a week away. I've found that many people put off filing their tax returns for many reasons. One of those reasons is that they cannot afford to pay a tax preparer or certified public accountant to help them and don't have the resources or access to try and file the returns on their own.

Free Assistance with Filing your Taxes

If you need help, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) offers a free program to help you prepare your tax forms. It is called the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program.

You can qualify for the VITA program if:

- 1. Your income is below \$54,000 per year,
- 2. English is NOT your first language, or
- 3. If you are physically disabled.

In addition, the IRS also offers Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE). This program assists taxpayers age 60 and over. TCE specializes in pension and retirement situations that are specific to seniors. These programs run through, at least, April 16. They are staffed with volunteers who have been trained and certified by the IRS. They typically are held in public libraries, strip malls, community centers and (sometimes) at colleges.

You can find out more about these free programs by visiting the IRS Website at www. IRS.gov or you can speak to a live operator by calling 1-800-906-9887. If you meet with a volunteer at one of these programs, you will need to be prepared to provide the past year's federal tax return, a picture ID, your proof of income or W-2 and any other relevant tax documents for the current year's taxes. If you anticipate a refund, you should also be prepared to provide a voided check as they will need it to have your correct bank information to electronically deposit your money in your account.

Remit Your Returns and Payments on Time

It is best to remit your federal tax returns on time to avoid interest and penalties that will be charged to you for a late filed return. If you owe federal tax debt, it is best to remit payment in a timely manner as well. If you are unable to pay the entire amount owed at the time you remit your return, it is still important to timely file the return and then seek options for repayment of the tax debt. My next article slated for April 25, 2018 will detail some options on how to handle a tax debt.

souls who died in sin and will suffer in hell for eternity. Scalfari said the pope had referenced good souls, but asked, "What about bad souls? Where are they punished?"

Pope Francis allegedly said, "They are not punished. Those who repent obtain the forgiveness of God and enter the rank of souls who contemplate him. But those who do not repent and cannot therefore be forgiven disappear. There is no hell, there is the disappearance of sinful souls."

The Vatican insists that the pope's response was more along the lines of, "Hell, in one of its forms, is a state of non-being."

The Vatican also took the position that the pope had engaged in a private conversation, not a formal interview, with his friend Scalfari, adding, "The textual words pronounced by the pope are not quoted. No quotation of the aforementioned article must therefore be considered as a faithful transcription of the words of the Holy Father."

That sounds like CYA mode to me. The pope's comments may have been off the record, but I am not sure how the conversation

with a noted journalist asking questions is not considered an interview.

Semantics aside, it sounds like the pope chose to fence-straddle instead of speaking frankly. Of all relevant topics, that should be the one with the least amount of ambiguity.

If there is no hell, or it is no big deal, why then did Christ give his human life in such cruel fashion to allow repentant and faithful Christians a salvation from sin?

The pope is considered infallible on matters of doctrine to members of the Catholic church when in the exercise of his office, as declared by the Vatican Council of Pius IX in 1870. Being the opinion of men, that declaration can be debated by those who would choose to do so.

However, I would contend that the pope should be responsible for his words and actions 24/7, not just in official Christian-mode. There is no time out or an allowance for off-the-record reality.

Interview or not, on the record or not, how can a person in his position utter anything less than definitive? Was it to placate to his unbelieving friend so as not to make him uncomfortable? How would that be in his best interest? Is that what

Christ would want him to say in that situation? For that matter, is it what Christ would want ANY OF US to say?

Or was it just more political correctness from Pope Francis who seems to be more concerned with the prevailing winds of opinion and kindness-at-all-cost rather than legitimate unwavering doctrine not subject to societal whims.

This incident just lends more credence to the argument that Christian doctrine is fluid around our lives and beliefs: That it can be only as applicable as we want it to be. That would certainly make things easier for us all. However, there is nothing scriptural to substantiate that position.

It may be fair to engage in some spirited dialogue as to what qualifies one as a Christian or if there are different degrees or levels of hell. However, for him to summarily dismiss the existence of eternal fire and brimstone and the gnashing of teeth in the face of extensive biblical support is unconscionable. The Pope is either exhibiting signs of dementia or it is a hauntingly real example of a wolf in sheep's clothing.

Regardless, for anyone who claims to be a soldier for Christ, it is dereliction of duty.

Medicare Minute

"Prescription Drug Extra Help"

Anyone who is on Medicare has the option of signing up for prescription drug coverage. This is also known as Medicare Part D. Some people with limited income and resources may be able to get "Extra Help" with the costs related to their Medicare prescription drug plan. This includes help with monthly premiums, annual deductibles and prescription co-payments.

To qualify for "Extra Help" your annual income must not exceed \$18,210 for an individual or \$24,960 for a married couple living together. Some of the things that count as income are: Social Security benefits, Railroad Retirement benefits, Veterans benefits, pensions or annuities and any wages you are earning from a job or self-employment.

You also must not exceed the resource limit to qualify for "Extra Help". Resources would include: bank accounts (including checking, savings and CDs), stocks, bonds, mutual funds, IRAs or any other investments. Cash and any real estate other than your home also counts. The amount of your resources must not exceed \$14,100 for an individual or \$28,150 for a married couple. The amounts listed for both the income and resource limits are for 2017.

Social Security has estimated that "Extra Help" is worth about \$4,000 per year for those who qualify. We meet with many people each year who qualify for this benefit and don't even know it. To find out if you qualify for "Extra Help" you can call or visit your local Social Security office, apply online at www.socialsecurity.gov or you can call or visit our office and we'll be glad to help. Regardless of the way you choose to apply, you will need your income and resource information available.



Termites!

The word can strike fear in the heart of any homeowner (or Realtor!). Our region, the southeastern U.S., is especially prone to subterranean termites. I sat down with my buddy Jeff Henry of Guaranteed Pest Control to find out what we should all know about these pests.

First of all, termites do in fact swarm. The swarmers are the reproductive members of the colony, and they come out in spring. Their activity is usually how people find out they have a termite problem. Interestingly, the swarmers do not actually do damage. They swarm, drop their wings, burrow in the ground (if outdoors) and start new colonies. The actual damage is done by worker termites, and they are protected by soldier termites. All of these little bugs can cost you a lot of money if they decide to make themselves at home in your house. The subterranean termites that live in our area do not create sawdust. In fact, if you are in your crawlspace and see pin-sized holes in the floor joists or subfloor, those are the work of powder post beetles. Those insects are second to fermites in cost of damage done by insects to homes in our

The good news is, state law mandates that every new home built in Alabama must be pretreated for termites. This pre-treatment is good for three to five years, or however long the carrier of the bond guarantees. From then on, the bond simply has to be renewed on time. You can also choose to add a termite bond to an existing home at any time, and the cost of a bond is usually far less than repairing damage.

The bad news is, termite damage is not covered by homeowner's insurance. If you're not covered and an active termite colony is found in your home, you not only have to repair the damage done, but also pay for treating the home and securing a bond. It is also important to remember that any time a slab is being poured within about 12 feet of your house, the form boards must be removed when the concrete is dry. If they are simply covered with dirt, that is an open invitation to termites.

It is spring in Alabama---for a few days, anyway. If you don't have termite protection, look into it. You may be surprised how inexpensive peace of mind can be. - mr



by then, the damage had been done. Most of the funding was from sources that are difficult to trace to real people.

As it turned out, all but \$10,000 of the \$4.4 million that Highway 31 raised came from three national Democrat-aligned entities: \$3.2 million from super PAC Senate Majority PAC, \$910,000 from super PAC Priorities USA Action, and \$250,000 from the non-profit League of Conservation Voters Inc. In other words, Highway 31 was a national powerhouse masquerading as a local creation.

Billionaire George Soros contributed \$1 million. Soros has stated publicly several times that he is god (not that he believes he is god—he states he is god). Soros makes little effort to conceal his contempt for America. He openly favors the collapse of the greenback and the decline of America in general. What a great asset for the Democrats!

Highway 31's second largest donor also provided dark money. Their source, super PAC Priorities USA Action, was the same one that generated \$192 million for Hillary and was Hillary's main super PAC supporter in 2016.

Learning "How" To Talk

Texting is an interesting phenomenon to me. Although I do a good bit of it, I never thought it would become as popular as it is today. To me, when you leave out the non-verbals in communication (tone, facial expression, etc.) it leaves interpretation rather risky. Hence, most of us have learned to text with care!

Words are loaded with power. Just a few of them from someone can cause your day to take a turn for better or worse. Solomon taught this very message long ago

when he wrote: "Death and life are in the power of the tongue..." (Proverbs 18:21). No wonder the Bible puts such a strong emphasis on keeping the tongue under control (cf. James 1:26; 3:1-12).

To take this a step further, it is not always "what" we say, but also "how" we say something (or how we "hear" something) that can make a huge difference. The following story is a good example of this.

A refugee once came to America to find work and start a new life. He only had enough money to duy his way here, thus leaving his wife benind until he could make enough to send for her. After a few months his wife had not heard from him so, with the help of a friend, she sent him a letter- - written in English. Since he was unable to read English, he asked a coworker to read it to him. Unfortunately, the coworker was an ill-tempered sort who spoke in a grumpy voice. Thus, he read rather angrily, "Why haven't you sent for me? I need the money right away!"

The immigrant grabbed the letter from the coworkers hand and said, "She has no right to speak to me that way! I'm doing the best I can!" A few weeks later another letter came in the mail- - again written in English. This time he asked another man to read it to him. This man was a gentle sort and read in a very pleasant voice, "Did you get my last letter? Why haven't you sent for me? I need the money right away." "Well," said the immigrant, "That's better. If she had not changed her tone, I wouldn't have sent for her at all!"

Yes, how we say what we say is just as important as what is said. Paul instructed, "Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer every man" (Colossians 4:6). May we all heed this truth so we can learn "how" to speak appropriately and effectively.

breath, death, life, and salvation. You can ignore Him now, but you'll





Dear Michael,

way to cover the difference between the amount of the lien and what you can get for the car. Let's say the car is worth \$12,000, and you owe \$15,000. That would leave you \$3,000 short.

The bank holds the title, so unless you give them the payoff amount of \$15,000 you're not getting the title. The easiest and simplest way would be if someone buys the car for \$12,000, and you had \$3,000 on hand to make up the difference. If you don't have the money to make up the difference, you could go to a local bank and or credit union and borrow the remaining \$3,000.

I really hate debt, but being \$3,000 in the hole is a lot better than being \$15,000 in the hole. Then, you could turn around and quickly pay back the \$3,000 you borrowed.

You'd give the total amount owed to the bank, they would give you the title, and you would sign it over to the new owner. Hope this helps!


