Livingston County Department of Health Tested Readiness

An exercise that tested the Livingston County Department of Health's plan to manage an infectious disease outbreak was conducted on April 10, 2018. The scenario was that an employee at a local grocery store was diagnosed with acute hepatitis A. Treatment or post-exposure prophylaxis was recommended for any customer that consumed produce purchased from this grocery store between March 27 and April 4. The Livingston County Department of Health offered hepatitis A vaccine and immune globulin (IG) to potentially exposed customers of the grocery store. The exercise included medical screenings, a medication consultation

component, and general education regarding public health emergencies. Individuals who participate in the exercise received a simulated/fake vaccine.

Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director stated, "It is important to test this area of our emergency preparedness plan. The ability to quickly and efficiently set up clinics during a public health emergency which could include infectious diseases such as, Hepatitis A is vital to keeping the community healthy".

Community partners included Dr. Witte of Tri County Family Medicine, Dansville Moose Club, Livingston County Sheriff's Office, Dansville Police Department, Livingston County Medical Reserve Corps, Lifetime Care, UR Medicine/Noyes Health, Dansville Emergency Services, Livingston County Emergency Medical Services, and Livingston County Office of Emergency Management.

Also, the Livingston County Department of Health is thankful to the community members who attended the exercise. The exercise benefited Livingston County residents, Livingston County Department of Health and its community partners in planning for future emergency events.






