

GOT ANOTHER CALL

Readers of this column have been a big aid to my addiction to nature photography by informing me about the locations of snowy owls, snow geese, eagles, ospreys and all sorts of neat nature stuff. I also get to meet some very nice people who appreciate wildlife as I do in the process.



The loon is a great fisherman and a unique bird.

Last week was not any different, my phone vibrated and Krys had a message for me - "A loon has been hanging out in by the bridge by the house." I'm off!

Loons are not an easy subject to find around here as they don't land on small bodies of water because they require up to one quarter mile of water surface runway to get airborne. This is because their wings are small as compared to their body size, and they are heavy, because unlike other birds their bones are almost solid. These features of course also make the loon a fabulous fisherman; his weight making it easier to dive and chase fish and his short wings to help him maneuver quickly under water to catch the fish.

Another problem a loon has are his legs, which are connected way back on his body. This is a big plus for propelling him under water but makes it almost impossible to walk on land. I learned this many years ago on a little known lake up near the St. Lawrence River called Mud Lake. I not only did a lot of waterfowl hunting on this small lake in the fall but spent a good amount of time there one summer. One day as I paddled my canoe around the lake I spotted a loon and foolishly thought I could get close enough for a good picture. It swam, mostly under water, up into a small bay with only a narrow channel going up into it. I thought "I got him" because there was only one way out - past me! He dove when he could no long go any further up into the bay and I stood up with my camera to be ready when he surfaced. That's when I spied him coming down that channel under the water right under my canoe. I don't think he could have gone any faster if he had been flying in the air! He surfaced way out in the lake, so far it was thought to be another loon.

Soon I learned something else: there was a very small island in that bay and on the edge I saw another loon laying down near the edge of the water trying to hide, I thought. As I watched her with my field glasses she pushed herself off that island with her legs (which were extremely far back for a bird) and quietly disappeared under the water. Paddling over there I discovered that she had been laying on a nest with two eggs and quickly left the area. That was why she pushed herself into the water with her legs instead of getting up. She really couldn't walk with those legs being so far back!

Loons have many other quite interesting things about them. For instance their eyes change colors with the season; red in the summer (thought to aid in attracting mates and spotting other loons from a distance) and gray or very dark red in the winter. Their body feathers also change colors from a very distinct black and white checker pattern with a "white necklace" around their neck in the winter to a grayish color with no pattern in the winter. Their ability to change direction under water aids them in catching their main food source – fish. They extend one foot laterally as a pivot brake and kick with the opposite foot to turn 180 degrees in a fraction of a second. When they dive their heartbeat slows which allows them to stay under water longer and also flatten their feathers to become more streamlined. When they catch a fish under the water they can swallow it there if it's small but if it is too big they will carry the slippery fish to the surface holding on to it with sharp teeth that protrude from the top of their mouths.

Loons are also known for their assorted loud eerie vocal calls which includes wails, hoots, vodels and tremolos (laughing). These calls are often heard at night and have confused some folks into thinking someone is calling for help!

So how did I make out with getting photos of this neat bird? Well I spent three different days waiting for shots and got some decent ones including bringing fish up but the lack of good sunlight those days did not help to get exactly what I was looking for. If he hangs around long enough the sun may come out and my chance may come but I'm not counting on it the way our weather has been going!

ABUSING THE PROCESS

When a person misuses the judicial process in order to achieve an improper goal, this misuse of the court system is a tort that is referred to as "abuse of process." This is not to be confused with the tort known as "malicious prosecution" that is predicated on the plaintiff having no justification for filing a lawsuit. In abuse of process, the lawsuit is justified, but one party uses the court's power to achieve an impermissible result. For example, someone may file a lawsuit, then start harassing the defendant with court motions and procedures in an attempt to force the defendant into settling the case rather than using court motions and procedures for the purposes they are intended to achieve.

Are Meal Delivery Services Right for Your Family?

Working parents are busy with commitments to work, family and their children's school and extracurricular activities. As a result of such commitments, families may find they have little time to devote to cooking, let alone shopping for food.

As an alternative to dining out, which can be expensive, many families are exploring home-delivery meal kits. Meal kits can provide a great way to try new foods, enticing eaters to try different recipes. They're also a good idea for families or singletons who may be bored preparing their typical staples.


Another advantage to meal kits is the portions of the meals are already determined, helping people better control how much they eat. Meal kit users also are unlikely to waste food, which might be common for those accustomed to preparing large meals they rarely finish.

Cost is usually the biggest detriment to meal kits. Even though meal kits may cost less per person than dining out, they're still on the expensive side. Meal kit devotees pay for the convenience of having someone plan, package and ship high-quality meals to their doorsteps. Meals may cost anywhere from \$50 to \$200 per week, with the average at about \$10 per meal, per person, says Pentallect. People who can get great deals at grocery stores may feel meal kits are not worth the cost.

Another potential problem with meal kits is that consumers may be at the mercy of the company in terms of the variety of foods available to them. Picky eaters may find the kits include items they will not eat, which can make kits a waste of money and food. Also, it may take some research to find companies that offer foods that fit with dietary preferences, such as those that cater to food allergies or vegan diets or companies that provide organically sourced ingredients.

Environmentalists may frown upon the excess packaging and cooling packs used in some meal kits. Consumers must be committed to recycling or reusing packaging to make meal kits more eco-friendly.

Families who want to give meal kits a try are urged to read reviews on services and check out available menus to ensure the investment is worth it. If convenience is key, meal kits may be the ideal fit.
