SHERIFFS INVESTIGATE MOTHER AND SON DEATHS IN KENDALL

The Orleans County Sheriff's Office is currently conducting an investigating into the circumstances involving the death of a mother and son in the Town of Kendall.

Orleans County Undersheriff Christopher Bourke reported that on April 18, 2018, at 7:27 p.m., the Orleans County Sheriff's 911 Center received a report of a propane gas leak at 2245 Center Road. Kendall Fire Department was dispatched and upon arrival discovered two bodies in an upstairs bedroom.

The deceased individuals were identified as Joan C. Gilman, 38, and her son Richard J. Gilman Jr., 14. The Sheriff's Office learned that the electrical powered had been turned off at the duplex a few days ago and a portable generator was being used along with some propane powered appliances during this period of time.

Both victims were transported to the Monroe County Medical Examiner's Office. The Sheriff's Office will continue the investigation and piece together the chain of events that led up to this tragedy.

Assisting the Sheriff's Office in this investigation are; The Kendall Fire Department, The Orleans County Major Felony Crime Task Force, The New York State Police Forensic Identification Unit, Town of Kendall Code Enforcement, Investigators from the New York State Academy of Fire Science and the Orleans County Coroner's Office.

OrleansHub.com had the response from Kendall Central School superintendent Julie Christenen. "It is with great sadness that I share the news of the sudden death of one of our students, Richard (RJ) Gilman Jr., and his mother, Joan," Julie Christensen, superintendent of Kendall Central School, said in a statement on the district website. "RJ was a ninth grade student at Kendall Junior/Senior High School (JSHS). He displayed an infectious sense of humor and an endearing personality.'

Counselors were at the school Thu., April 19 and Fri., April 20. If people need support after school hours, they are encouraged to contact the Orleans County Mental Health Care and Crisis Hotline at 585-344-4400.

"Each one of us copes with loss and grief differently," Christensen said.

Time Your Move Right to Save Money

Buying a new home is the most expensive purchase a person is likely to make in his or her lifetime. It also can be one of the more stressful. High-Paying Professions

Much of the talk centered on women in the workforce concerns the disparity between earnings when compared against men in the same positions. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics indicates that the earnings difference between women and men varies with age, with younger women in the country more closely approaching pay equity than older women. Still, Pew Research Center says the female median annual earnings is around 83 percent of what men earn in the United States.

The gender pay gap exists to some extent in every country in the world. Statistics Canada points out that women between the ages of 25 and 54 earned 87 cents an hour for every dollar made by men in 2015. Business Insider UK says Iceland, Finland and Norway boast relatively small pay gaps between the genders.

Even though a gender wage gap exists, women can still pursue careers that are known to be well-paying. The following are some of the top-earning positions women (and men) can consider, courtesy of Forbes, Monster.com and the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

· Obstetrician/Gynecologist: Many women feel more comfortable being examined or discussing female issues with female doctors. This may account for the higher percentage of female OB/GYNs in practice. The job can be very rewarding because it enables one to care for women at various stages in life. The median annual salary for OB/GYNs is \$207,000.

· Chief executive: It's a large responsibility overseeing an entire company or division, but that's what chief executives do on a daily basis. Approximate median annual earnings are \$97,552.

· Pharmacist: Pharmacists manage the distribution of medications, but they also consult patients on medication use and administer some immunizations. Some pharmacists work in drug or grocery stores, while others are employed in clinical settings. The median annual salary for pharmacists is \$95,628.

· Optometrist: Responsible for the examination and care of their patients' eves, optometrists also determine prescriptions for glasses and contacts. Optometrists earn a median annual salary of \$102,000.

· Attorney: Lawyers are consumers' advocate and help explain the often confusing nuances of the law. Attorneys may specialize in different areas, such as corporate law or family law. Attorney salaries vary depending on the specialty lawyers choose, but law can be a very lucrative field.

Computer and Information System Manager: These workers are also known as Information Technology (IT) Managers. They coordinate and implement company-wide IT efforts, including networking, database development and trouble-shooting. IT managers earn median annual salaries of \$87,400.

Crab Salad-Stuffed Tomatoes

Serves 2

1/3 cup orzo

- 2 large tomatoes
- 1 cup crabmeat, picked over for pieces of shell
- 1/3 cup chopped black or green olives
- 2 tablespoons crumbled reduced-fat feta cheese
- 2 tablespoons chopped fresh dill
- 2 teaspoons balsamic vinegar
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon black pepper

1. Cook orzo according to package directions, omitting salt if desired. Drain and rinse under cold water; drain again.

2. Meanwhile, cut thin slice off tops of tomatoes; reserve tops. Using spoon, carefully scoop out seeds and pulp; reserve for another use.

3. Gently toss together crabmeat, olives, feta, dill, vinegar, salt, and pepper in medium bowl. Spoon crabmeat mixture evenly into tomato shells and cover with reserved tomato tops.

Cook's note: Scoop the seeds and pulp from the tomatoes into a storage container. Cover and freeze up to 4 months and toss them into a soup or stew.

The Various Types of Arthritis

Arthritis affects hundreds of millions of people across the globe. The Arthritis Foundation® notes that more than 50 million adults in the United States have some type of arthritis, while the European League Against Rheumatism estimates that rheumatic diseases such as rheumatoid arthritis affect more than 120 million people in the European Union. In Canada, the Canadian Community Health Survey found that 16 percent of Canadians age 15 and older were affected by arthritis.

The Arthritis Foundation notes that arthritis is not a single disease. In fact, the word "arthritis" is something of an umbrella term and an informal way of referring to joint pain or joint disease. While these conditions may produce some common symptoms, such as swelling, pain and stiffness, learning to distinguish between some common types of arthritis can help men and women manage their conditions more effectively.

Osteoarthritis

Osteoarthritis, which is sometimes referred to as "degenerative joint disease" or "OA," is the most common chronic condition of the joints. The symptoms of OA vary depending on the joints that are affected, but pain and stiffness, especially first thing in the morning or after resting, are common. OA can affect the hips, knees, fingers, or feet, and those with OA may feel limited range of motion in their affected areas. Some with OA may hear clicking or cracking sounds when the affected joints bend, and pain associated with OA may be more intense after activity or toward the end of the day.

Inflammatory arthritis

Inflammatory arthritis occurs when the immune system, which can employ inflammation to fight infection and prevent disease, mistakenly attacks the joints with uncontrolled inflammation. Such a mistake can

contribute to joint erosion and even organ damage. Psoriatic arthritis, which the Arthritis Foundation notes affects roughly 30 percent of people with psoriasis, and rheumatoid arthritis are two examples of inflammatory arthritis. Genetics and environmental factors, such as smoking, may trigger instances of inflammatory arthritis.

Infectious arthritis

Bacterium, a virus or a fungus that enters the joint may trigger inflammation and lead to infection arthritis. The Arthritis Foundation notes that the most common bacteria to cause infection arthritis staphylococcous aureus, is or staph. The majority of infectious arthritis cases occur after an infection somewhere else in the body travels through the bloodstream to the joint, though some infections may enter the joint directly through a puncture wound near the joint or during surgery near the joint. Intense swelling and pain, typically in a single joint, are the most common symptoms of infectious arthritis, which is most likely to affect the knee, though it can affect the hips, ankles and wrists. Some people with infection arthritis may also experience fever and chills.

The body produces uric acid to break down purines, a substance found in many foods and in human cells. But some people produce more uric acid than they need, which they then struggle to get rid of quickly. As a result, uric acid can build up. The Arthritis Foundation notes that this buildup can lead to the formation of needle-like crystals in the joints that cause sudden spikes of extreme pain.

Infant Sleep Cycles

Babies do not develop regular sleep cycles until about six months of age. According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, newborns may only sleep one or two hours at a time but still sleep roughly 16 hours per day. The AAP notes that newborn sleep occurs in stages and is divided about equally between rapid eye movement (REM) and non-REM sleep. The first stage of newborn sleep is characterized by drowsiness as babies begin to fall asleep. That drowsiness is followed by REM sleep, during which babies may twitch or jerk their arms or legs. During this stage, parents may notice their babies' eyes moving under closed eyelids. In addition, a condition called "normal periodic breathing of infancy," in which babies' breathing can be irregular and even stop for five to 10 seconds before starting again with rapid breathing that continues for 10 to 15 seconds, may occur. The rapid breathing during the REM stage will be followed by regular breathing until the cycle begins anew and repeats itself. The AAP advises parents that, during the pauses of normal periodic breathing of infancy, babies' skin color does not change and parents need not be concerned. The third stage of newborn sleep is light sleep, a less active phase during which babies' breathing becomes more regular. The fourth and fifth stages are deep non-REM sleep. During these stages, babies fall into a sleep that progressively deepens to a point where babies

may be difficult to wake.



SIGNS OF A STROKE
