





**NEW CASE ON FAMILY LAW** 

We do not do contested divorces. There are really good divorce lawyers in this area and you should consider using a lawyer that emphasizes a particular field of practice. That said the Court recently

released a decision that really shows how complicated divorce agreements can be. A poorly worded agreement can result in people not understanding

where they stand legally. In fact, there is a recent case where there was a dispute within the Appellate Court about which standard or rule to apply because of inconsistent wording in two different agreements concerning custody of children. These people are lawyers and judges and they didn't agree.

Remember when a divorce court decides the issue of custody for the first time, the rule applied is the answer to the question "what is in the best interests of the child or children?" This question is just "more likely than not" 51/49 percent issue and whichever side wins is where the children will be placed.

After the court decides where the children will reside based on the "best interests" test it is virtually impossible to modify custody without agreement of both parties. In the early 1980s the courts decided that children were not to be yanked around from parent to parent without really important changes taking place. It is not enough to make more money or remarry or even change one's lifestyle according to the case that decided this, Ex parte McLendon (1984).

The problem in the recent case was that the people (or their lawyers more likely) had worded their agreement in a way that gave both parties almost equal custodial periods of visitation with the children. The term "custodial visitation" created a situation that led to uncertainty, legal fees and appeals to the Appellate Court that probably cost thousands of dollars. If joint custody is what is wanted the agreement should state "the parties agree that they shall have joint legal and physical custody of the minor children."

That's fine for people who co-parent and get along and something different needs to be done in those cases where they don't. The point is that whatever is intended by the parties needs to be clear and consistent in their agreement. Buckle up, drive safely and as always your referrals are appreciated! 256-764-0112





## **Medicare Minute** "Durable Medical Equipment"

Durable Medical Equipment are items such as walkers, wheelchairs, and hospital beds that are used in the home. Medicare will cover certain durable medical equipment only if your physician prescribes it. To be prescribed the durable medical equipment must be: durable, or reusable, used for a medical purpose, and primarily used at home. Durable medical equipment is covered under Medicare Part B.

Some examples of items that qualify as durable medical equipment are, but not limited to: Oxygen equipment and supplies, walkers, wheelchairs, hospital beds, infusion supplies, and patient lifts. Remember, these items should be used primarily at home. If you are residing in a nursing home or hospital, and that facility is providing you with Medicare covered care, it may not be considered your home. If you are staying in a skilled nursing facility, that facility will usually provide the durable medical equipment you need.

If you need durable medical equipment, make sure your doctor and durable medical equipment supplier are enrolled in Medicare. If you doctor or supplier is not enrolled, Medicare will not pay the claims they submit. Without any type of supplemental insurance, you typically will be responsible for 20% of the Medicare approved amount. Also, if you are on a Medicare Advantage Plan you may have copays or coinsurance.

One last thing. There are companies out there that will place outbound calls to Medicare beneficiaries offering to send you durable medical equipment or other items for free. A lady told us just last week this happened to her. The company offered to send her a knee brace at no cost. She didn't need the knee brace but they wanted to send it anyway. These companies will send you the item, then bill Medicare. Remember, nothing is free!! Someone is always paying.



Active debate can always take place as to which performers and bands deserve to be enshrined in the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame. My musical career ended with my last guitar in elementary lesson school. Nonetheless, I've been a fan ever since, and I still frequently find 105.5 on the radio dial.

It remains extremely disappointing that the progressive rock group, Kansas, was not enshrined long ago.



Kansas was founded in 1970-71. They exploded onto the scene only a couple of years later

Kirshner Records on with nine amazing studio albums in ten years. The core group was Phil Ehart, Dave Hope, Kerry Livgren, Robbie Steinhardt, Steve Walsh, and Rich Williams. Twelve albums/CD's have followed through 2016 (not including Best Ofs) with only modest personnel changes. They continue touring. Many local rock fans recall the early Kansas performance at Norton Auditorium in '76.

Kansas (the state and the band) is named after the Kansa Native American tribe which inhabited that area. The term is said to mean, "People of the Southern Wind.

At least two of their songs are legendary "Carry On Wayward Son", and "Dust in the Wind". Several others are wellknown - "What's on my Mind", "People of the South Wind", "Point of Know Return", "Sparks of the Tempest", "Play the Game Tonight", etc.

Others are simply brilliant - "Icarus (Borne on Wings of Steel)", "Miracles



## **ON YOUR DEBT**

## What If I Owe **Federal and State Income Taxes?**

**McNutt** Managing It is about this time each year when Attorney television and radio advertising increases for various companies (usually from California) stating they can help you if you owe back income taxes. Just send us your first born and loads of cash and we will

make it go away. I am often asked if back income taxes can be discharged, that is gotten rid of, in Bankruptcy. The answer is not always an easy one. Please remember that even if they are not dischargeable in a straight (chapter 7) bankruptcy case, you can include the tax debt in a chapter 13 reorganization and repay what you owe over time.

#### **Discharging Income Back Taxes**

Income taxes that are owed "may" be dischargeable in bankruptcy if the following requirements are met:

1. The tax return for the year or years in question was due more than 3 years before the date the bankruptcy case was filed;

2. The tax return was filed at least 2 years before the bankruptcy case was filed; and

3. There has been no new assessment of the taxes within the 240 days before the bankruptcy is filed.

Understanding the Requirements

These above requirements may seem somewhat straightforward, but it is essential to first get an account transcript from the IRS for each year taxes are owed to see if they have been met. Let me assure you that reading and understanding an IRS transcript is not easy and you will need someone familiar with one to be able to interpret the same. Now let's review the 3 requirements.

1. Tax returns are normally due on April 15 of the following year. Therefore, the 2014 federal tax return is due on April 15, 2015 (if the 15th is on a Saturday or Sunday, then the due date could be the 16th or 17th). If an extension is requested, then the due date would likewise move to October 15, 2015 or the 16th or 17th. For this example, assume the 2014 return is filed on 4-15-15 and thus the date necessary to meet the first requirement is April 16, 2018.

2. The 2 year rule means that the return or returns in question must have been filed with the IRS at least 2 years before the bankruptcy case is filed. So even though you may meet the 3 year requirement above, if the bankruptcy case is filed 1 year after the tax return is filed, the taxes owed are not dischargeable. To safely meet this requirement, you need to file your taxes on time.

3. Has there been a new assessment of taxes for a particular tax year within 240 days of the bankruptcy case being filed? For example, if the IRS has disallowed a tax deduction and you owe more tax, this rule will impact your ability to discharge the tax. If the assessment took place 220 days before the bankruptcy case is filed, then the taxes will still be owed after the bankruptcy. If the assessment took place 241 days before the bankruptcy case is filed, then the taxes can be dischargeable if 1 and 2 are also met.

There are also a few types of tax debt that are simply not dischargeable. These include trust fund taxes and taxes for civil penalties. However, the collection of trust fund taxes may be subject to a statute of limitations. There are other situations too detailed to discuss in this short explanation that would affect the time periods mention above such as tolling of the 2-year roll. (What?)

Owing the IRS is serious business and not something to put in the hands of an out of state tax resolution company to which your only contact is by phone or email and they want your money first regardless of







proactive in providing an opportunity for the correct disposal of substances that might result in overdose, abuse, or accidental poisoning," said Tuscumbia Police Chief Tony Logan.

"In addition, parents should seriously consider bringing their children by to obtain a set of fingerprints. In the unthinkable event of a missing child, a set of fingerprints is an invaluable tool for locating them. Fingerprints are unique and don't change over time," Logan added.

According to the DEA, expired, unused, or unwanted prescription medications are a public safety issue. Unused drugs thrown in the trash can be retrieved and abused or illegally sold.


Unused drugs that are flushed contaminate the water supply. Proper disposal of unused drugs saves lives and protects the environment.

## NEGOTIATING





## Money Cannot Buy Everything

I am not much of a movie buff. But there is a fairly recent release from Hollywood that did catch my attention titled, "All The Money In The World." Since it is rated "R" I probably will never see it unless it is released as a TV version, but let me tell you why it appeals to me.

It is a story based on the life of J. Paul Getty. Mr. Getty became well-known around the world due to the wealth and influence he gained through the oil industry. In 1957, Fortune magazine deemed him the "richest living

American." Further, in 1966 Guinness Book of World Records identified him as the world's richest private citizen. When he died in 1976 he was worth more than \$6 billion dollars (which today would be approximately \$26 billion).

However, the appeal of this movie to me is not about having money, but the lesson of what money cannot buy. Too many folks tend to think that if they just had enough money that all of their problems would come to an end. But the J. Paul Getty story is just one of many others that prove that thinking to be seriously flawed. As I watched the trailer for the movie I was reminded of a piece I read several years ago. It was a quote from Getty's autobiography and printed in the Los Angeles Times in 1981. Mr. Getty wrote, "I have never been given to envy... save for the envy I feel toward those people who have the ability to make a marriage work and endure happily. It's an art I have never been able to master. My record: five marriages, five divorces. In short, five failures." The article went on to describe that Getty's relationship with his five sons was "painful." For example, his oldest son apparently committed suicide and another son was said to live a "tortured existence." They were all estranged and aloof. Further, many will remember that his grandson was kidnapped and held for ransom in 1973. When Mr. Getty refused to pay, the kidnappers cut off his grandson's right ear. Did money buy him a loving, peaceful, worry-free life? Not even close. I am not suggesting that anyone who has money has a terrible life. I am suggesting that if they have a good life, that money has little to do with it. Money cannot buy the most important things in life. And most importantly, it cannot buy our way into heaven. Jesus challenged long ago, "What profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? (Matthew 16:26).




