Wiinblad Chair

Many artists don't create just pictures or sculptures. They make furniture, jewelry, dinnerware or even kitchen tools and toys. In the 1920s and '30s, there was a new title for these multi-talented artists: industrial designer. They redesigned existing large machines like trains or trucks, and small household goods like telephones and clocks. The result was better-looking objects that were less expensive to make.



This very modern-looking chair is part of a dining-room set designed by Bjorn Wiinblad in 1970. The six chairs and matching table sold in

Collectors today may not have space in their homes for the largest industrial machines, but they can find examples of smaller decorative items by these famous men. A few designers to look for are Russel Wright (dinnerware, furniture, aluminum); Henry Teague Dreyfuss (Kodak camera); Henry (telephone); Lurelle Guild (aluminumware, vacuum cleaner): Viktor Schreckengost (Cowan pottery, pedal cars, dinnerware); and Bjorn Wiinblad (posters, furniture, dinnerware and tanestries)

At a summer Rago auction in Lambertville, New Jersey, a 1970s Wiinblad table and six matching chairs sold for \$1,875. The black lacquered pieces had a different colorful modern design on each chair back and tabletop. They

are large examples of Wiinblad's talent. But his ashtrays and dishes, decorated with drawings of round-faced people in pseudo 19th-century clothes and often surrounded by vines, floral wreaths and trees, can be found online and in shops for less than \$50. ***

Play Ball baseball cards were included with the gum from 1929 to 1941. The 1940 set included 240 different cards. In 1948 Gum, Inc. became Bowman, which was bought by Topps Chewing Gum in 1956. Your cards are of little value because they were glued to the dresser and are in poor condition. Cards for Appleton, Kress and Nelson are worth about \$5, if in poor condition. Hank Greenberg's card is worth more because he's in the Hall of Fame. It's worth about \$30 in good condition and half that in poor condition.

Wild onions were among the first foods that mankind gathered and ate, and are one of the first signs of spring. Onions are in the allium family along with garlic and shallots. There's nothing like the intense flavor (or the smell) of an onion! Spring onions are my favorite type of onion, both as an ingredient and as a vibrant, flavorful garnish. Spring onions also are called green onions, young onions, pencil onions and scallions.

Scallions aren't as fully ripened as a green onion and should not have a bulb. Spring onions are the milder, first stage of a mature onion. If left in the ground to grow, they'll form into an onion bulb.

Larger, older spring onions may have limp or faded stalks and a stronger flavor than the smaller ones. Spring onions should be small and thin, with a firm base at the root tip and crisp, bright green leaves. Select spring onions that are not fully developed, with a white bulb end and long, green stalks. The flavor of the leaves is milder than the root end. Spring onions will keep for five to seven days when wrapped in plastic and stored in the refrigerator.

Spring onions are a great source of

Use the leaves to add a wonderful burst of green color, to tie up appetizers into a package or to use as a frilly, edible garnish. To curl the ends, cut off the roots and all but about 3 inches of the green tops. Slice the tops lengthwise down from the green end into the white section. Put the leaves in cold water and chill for several hours to curl them.

While spring onions are best served raw, they're also delicious grilled or sauteed. They should be added during the final stages of a recipe for maximum flavor. This recipe is a showcase for two vegetables that will brighten up your dinner plate with the colors and flavors of spring! asparagus and discard. Slice asparagus diagonally into thirds and set aside. Slice spring onions or green onions in 1/4-inch slices and set aside. 2. Add the olive oil and the butter to a medium pan over medium heat. When the butter begins to bubble, add the spring onions, garlic and Italian seasoning, and saute until the onions begin to soften, about 2-4 minutes.

3. Add the asparagus and sprinkle the vegetables with the salt and black pepper. Combine the ingredients and saute, uncovered for 7-10 minutes or until the asparagus can be pierced easily with a fork.

In The Garden

Invite Hummingbirds And Butterflies To Your Garden

(NAPSA)—Butterflies and hummingbirds can add magic to any garden, and it's easy to invite them in. Just select the right plants—butterflies like bright colors while hummingbirds and butterflies both like blooms with plenty of nectar.

Easy-to-grow plants that attract pollinators include butterfly bushes, Rose of Sharon, and Weigela.

Butterfly bush (Buddleia) is a favorite of butterflies and hummingbirds. The sweet fragrance and bright summer flowers are appealing to people, too. Unfortunately, traditional butterfly bush varieties have a tendency to get overgrown and leggy. Regular pruning is often needed to keep them in check. New Lo & Behold 'Blue Chip'

New Lo & Behold 'Blue Chip' Buddleia is a miniature butterfly bush with all the fragrance and butterfly appeal of older varieties but in a smaller package. It stays just 24"-30" tall and

It stays just 24"-30" tall and wide without any pruning, and produces abundant lavender blue flowers from midsummer to frost. This continuously blooming butterfly magnet does not need deadheading, and makes a fantastic low-maintenance mass planting. A noninvasive hybrid, Blue Chip is perfect for anyone who wants to attract butterflies and hummingbirds but doesn't have space for a big plant. It can be incorporated into container gardens.

While not as petite as Blue Chip, 'Miss Ruby' is a compact new

variety with intense flower color. Its vivid magenta flowers are richer and brighter than those of other varieties. Miss Ruby matures to approximately 4'-5' tall and wide, not as small as Blue Chip but much more manageable than the 6'-8' range of many older varieties. These new varieties are easy to

These new varieties are easy to grow in full sun and are hardy to USDA Zone 5. Butterfly bushes tolerate most moist, well-drained soils. Buddleia may be trimmed back in later winter or early spring, although pruning is usually not necessary with these new varieties.

Rose of Sharon (Hibiscus syriacus) is another easy-to-grow plant that attracts butterflies and hummingbirds. They bloom in mid- to late summer and are available in a wide variety of colors.

fon is especially nice in the evening, while gardeners looking for deep color will appreciate the rich violet of Violet Satin.

Weigela are even more diverse in size, shape, color and foliage. Wine & Roses is popular for attracting hummingbirds. Fine Wine is a smaller version of this favorite, and dwarf Midnight Wine is smaller yet.

My Monet is another miniature Weigela. Its green and white variegated leaves often blush pink to match its pink spring flowers. The chartreuse foliage on reblooming Ghost



Miss Ruby has vivid magenta flowers that are richer and brighter than other varieties. They only reach four to five feet tall.

Weigela transforms to iridescent buttercream in late summer. Weigelas are fast-growing plants that thrive in full sun.



breathing issues, surgery can be done to shorten the soft palate.

While these may cause slight changes in Granby's appearance, they can drastically improve his quality of life and overall health.

Pets are increasingly receiving cos-metic surgery. A CBS report said that dog owners in the U.S. spent \$62 million in 2011 on such treatments. For pugs like Granby as well as many bull-dogs and Boston terriers, corrective surgeries are often necessary. Likewise for shar-peis, which may need surgery to raise their eyelids, improving vision and preventing medical issues like scratched corneas.

However, other procedures are more cosmetic - lifting saggy skin around the face or abdomen, for example. And apparently some owners opt to give their dogs testicular implants after neutering, so they're (hopefully) less likely to notice or be bothered by the loss of their real testicles.

On the plus side, Granby's surgery appears to be medically necessary and might be covered by some pet insurance plans.
