

NAMING A **PERSONAL GUARDIAN**

Among the many gutwrenching prospects that people face when drawing up their wills is the matter of who will care for their minor children in the event that one or both parents die before the children reach adulthood. 



What is PMI? Primary mortgage insurance,

or PMI, protects lenders in the

event that borrowers default on their primary mortage by ceasing to make payments, resulting in homes ending up in foreclosure. But all borrowers do not have to pay PMI. Typically, home buyers must make a 20 percent down payment on a home when they buy it. However, some borrowers are unable to put down 20 percent. In such instances, the lender will require they pay PMI. This is because the lender views a borrower who cannot make an initial 20 percent down payment as a riskier investment, and lenders charge PMI in an effort to protect themselves should the borrower prove worthy of their skepticism. PMI will be factored into the monthly mortgage payment, but borrowers should know they do not have to continue paying PMI once they have paid enough toward the principal amount of the loan. For most, this means once they have paid 20 percent of the principal, then they can ask that the monthly PMI payment be removed. Many borrowers are unaware of this or even forget to ask, but it's within their rights as borrowers and can save a substantial amount of money over the course of the mortgage loan. \blacksquare



Reverse mortgages enable seniors to retire comfortably in their own homes. But that comfort does come with some drawbacks.

Chances are you have come across an advertisement for a reverse mortgage and have probably wondered what this type of mortgage is all about. Geared toward seniors, reverse mortgages are growing in popularity and inspiring the curiosity of older homeowners.

A reverse mortgage is a loan offered to people over the age of 62 that enables borrowers to convert part of the equity in their homes into cash. People of retirement age may find that their limited income can make monthly expenses more difficult. Reverse mortgages were conceived as a method to helping people at this stage in life use the money they put into their homes to pay off debts or cover routine living

expenses. The loan is dubbed "reverse mortgage" because instead of the homeowner paying money to a lender as is customary with a traditional mortgage, the lender makes payments to the borrower. What's more, the borrower is not required to pay back the loan until the home is sold or vacated. As long as a person is living in the home he or she is not required to make any payments toward the reverse mortgage loan balance. However, the borrower must remain current on insurance and tax payments.

When a person takes out a reverse mortgage, he or she may borrow a portion of the market value on the home. As of 2012, the maximum loan amount available in the United States was \$625,000. Any outstanding existing mortgages are paid off with the proceeds of the reverse mortgage, and either a lump sum of the balance or monthly payments are established. A homeowner may also opt for a line of credit with the reverse mortgage proceeds. Here is a more in-depth look at the pros and cons to reverse mortgages.

A reverse mortgage enables seniors to live in their homes for the rest of their lives without fear of mortgage payments. Because there are no payments being made during the life of the loan, borrowers do not have to meet income requirements or credit checks.

As long as the borrower continues to maintain residence in the home, he or she is still eligible for the monthly payments received through the reverse mortgage. This money can be used for any purpose and is tax-free. Borrowers can opt to modernize their homes or make safety improvements. The funds can also be put toward medical expenses or travel or to help family with their own financial needs.

Because the government insures the reverse mortgage program, borrowers need not worry about receiving their payments. Should a lender fail to make a payment, the borrower is eligible for that money and a late fee as well.

Another benefit of reverse mortgages is they protect homeowners against falling home prices. If the value of the home drops after the

loan is negotiated, it will not affect the equity value assessed for the life of the loan.

One down side to reverse mortgages is that the loans have higher up-front fees than other types of financing. Borrowers have to pay not only an origination fee and closing costs, but mortgage insurance costs as well. These initial costs can be several thousands of dollars. Unlike a traditional mortgage, where the balance gets lower and lower over time, with a reverse mortgage, no payments are being made on the loan. This means the loan balance simply gets larger over time depending on how much money is drawn from the home's equity. At the end of the loan, when the homeowner moves from the property or the premises is vacated upon the borrower's death, the value of the estate decreases based on the pay-off value of the reverse mortgage loan. Heirs will pay off the mortgage by selling the home and will only inherit the remaining money after the reverse mortgage lender has the loan satisfied. This means men and women will be leaving less money for their heirs, but those heirs will not be personally

liable if the home sells for less than the value of the mortgage. The mortgage lender has to claim a loss and request reimbursement from the Federal Housing Administration.

Something many seniors may not be aware of with regard to reverse mortgages is that these loans can affect eligibility for some need-based programs. Although Social Security and Medicare are not affected, Medicaid and other government assistance programs can be affected if a senior has a surplus of funds from a reverse mortgage that are not spent during the month.

A reverse mortgage is a long-term solution. People who are looking for a short-term fix will find that this type of loan probably doesn't meet their needs. Furthermore, it is hard to be approved for reverse mortgages on newly purchased homes. Lenders usually like to see at least six months or a year chain of title on a property before issuing a reverse mortgage.

Many seniors often find reverse mortgages confusing. Seniors may unwittingly agree to a loan without fully understanding the scope of the reverse mortgage. It is advisable to seek counseling on reverse mortgages before applying for one.





WHAT ABOUT OUR EAGLES? By Douglas H. Domedion

"How are the eagles doing?" I get asked

that a lot because many folks know I monitor the local nests for the DEC. It is something that started a long time ago when I use to go

out with Peter Nye and Mike Allen when they came each year to climb up into our local nests to band and check on the eaglets. Pete of course was in charge of the NYS DEC Endangered Species Unit and Mike was his partner from Region 8; the guys who spent their careers to bring the Bald Eagle back to NYS after a long absence due to the infamous DDT chemical.

Today we have around 300 pairs of nesting eagles in the State with seven nests locally and another trying very hard to nest on Ringneck Marsh on the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge. It has not been a very good year for our majestic birds with weather being the negative factor.

Let's start with the pair of eagles that have been trying to nest on the INWR on Ringneck Marsh.

This is the second year that this pair of birds has tried to nest on an island out in this marsh. For some reason, lost to me, the refuge manager refuses to give the birds the peace they need to nest. Both years the birds have been disturbed during their nest building process by a handful of ice fisherman. Then as soon as the winter weather breaks folks are allowed to walk out on the dike that eventually gets 200 yards from the nest. As people walk down this dike to hike, fish or get a closer look or picture of the eagles they spook them off. My many hours of observation, many of which are before refuge personnel show up at work or after they leave or on weekends when they are not around, has shown me with out a doubt that when people on the dike or ice fishing there are no eagles around but when there are no folks the eagles are there either working on the nest or protecting their territory. This year again the pair finally abandoned the nest. It is too bad as this was a location where the public could much more easily watch an eagle nest than any other in the area.

This brings me to another nest on the INWR, the Cayuga Marsh nest off Route 77. This was the only other nest that was possible for the public to observe. It is far and when the leaves come out they do get in the way but with a good scope the activities there can be seen. Not this year though as one of our late winter storms caused a nest failure after the young had hatched. Now there is no eagle nest activity for the public to see. The Ringneck Marsh eagles may have been an alternate observation area for the public had

There is another eagle nest on the INWR that is way back in and because no one at the INWR seemed to know what was going on there I hiked back in with a scope to find out for myself recently. A very mature eaglet was in the nest and I was surprised at his advance growth stage, ahead of anything I have witnessed before at this time of the year. Then there is the new nest on the INWR on the north western border. My observations showed one eaglet to be in that nest.

On the State Tonawanda WMA the well established nest there did not produce this year. The birds worked on the nest a lot but never produced eggs for some unknown

On the Oak Orchard WMA the old pair of eagles there (the female is 13 years old now) built a new nest on the very top of a 90-foot white pine on their island. It was a very large nest for only being built recently and I didn't like the way it was exposed to the wind and the fact that it was not well supported. Well shortly after she hatched out we had one of our nasty wind storms and part of the nest and the "bowel" was blown down. The next day DEC Wildlife Technician Denise Appleby and her assistant paddled out to the island and located two eaglets dead under the nest debris. They were less than one week old.

Now off the refuge areas. The nest I call the Hartway nest has one eaglet in it. The other nest which I call the Carlton nest has one eaglet in it also.

So of the seven nests we do have, with another one attempting to nest, only four eaglets are being produced this year. Of those four probably only two will survive to be producing birds at 5 years of age.

I'm always looking for new nests in our area and many reports from readers of this column make me think we have undiscovered nests out there. If you think you know of one give me or the local DEC office a call at 585-9485182. Keep in mind that eagle nest





Try Something New This Grilling Season

Many people feel no backyard barbecue is complete without staples like hot dogs and hamburgers. But grillmasters need not feel beholden to such fare if their hearts and stomachs desire something less traditional.

One of the joys of grilling is that there is a seemingly endless array of foods that can be cooked over an open flame. Grilled foods can be lean and healthy while still providing that unmistakable flavor unique to the grill. People who want to expand their grilling horizons while still providing juicy, delicious fare can try the following recipe for "Tandoori Turkey Burgers with Grilled Red Onions and Tomatoes" from Karen Adler and Judith Fertig's "The Gardener & Th Grill" (Running Press).

Tandoori Turkey Burgers with Grilled Red Onions & Tomatoes

Serves 4

TURKEY BURGERS

1 pound ground turkey

1/4 cup fine, dry breadcrumbs

- 2 tablespoons plain yogurt
- 1 teaspoon turmeric
- 1 teaspoon ground coriander I teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon fine kosher or sea salt Transmission

CUMIN YOGURT SAUCE

1/2 cup plain yogurt 1/2 teaspoon ground cumin Kosher or sea salt &

freshly ground black pepper to taste

2 large red onions, thickly sliced

2 large beefsteak tomatoes, thickly sliced

4 seeded hamurger buns

Olive oil, for brushing

Kosher or sea salt and freshly ground

black pepper to taste

1 cup shredded lettuce 2 tablespoons chopped fresh cilantro

• Prepare a medium-hot fire in your grill.

• In a large bowl, combine the ground turkey, breadcrumbs, yogurt, turmeric, coriander, cumin, and salt until well-blended. Form into four 3/4-inch-thick patties.

- For the cumin yogurt sauce, combine the cumin and yogurt together in a bowl until smooth. Season to taste with salt and pepper.
- Toss the shredded lettuce and cilantro in a bowl and set aside.
- Lightly brush the sliced onions, tomatoes and cut side of the hamburger buns with olive oil and season with salt and pepper, Grill the patties, onions and tomatoes directly over the fire. Grill the tomatoes for about 2 to 3 minutes on each side. Turn the burgers once after 7 to 8 minutes, then grill for another 7 to 8 minutes, or until the burgers are no longer pink inside and an instant-read thermometer registers 160 F in the center of each patty.
- Grill the onions for about 8 to 9 minutes, turning once halfway through the cooking time, or until softened and slightly charred. During the last minutes of grilling, toast the buns, cut side down, directly over the fire.
- To serve, place a patty on each bun. Top with a slice of grilled onion, tomato and 1/4 cup of lettuce mixture and a dollop of yogurt sauce. Serve the extra grilled onion and tomato slices on the side.
