



events and seminars, online support group, websites, fact sheets, clinical trials connections, pediatric stroke and hemiplegia research awards, and pediatric stroke awareness campaigns.

Dennis' wife, Betsy Wilson, is the inspiration for this fundraiser.

"At six months of age she was diagnosed with a stroke which likely happened before birth," Dennis explained in a press release. "It's still unknown why the stroke happened, but it injured the left side of Betsy's brain. Doctors thought she would never be able to walk, talk, or be independent in any way.

"However, as a miracle of her own will and the support of her family, Betsy was able to do everything most professionals thought was not possible."

Professionals believe that because her brain injury occurred so early in her development, the right side of her brain trained itself to perform many of the functions that her left side would have normally performed.

"All of this didn't come without its own unique challenges," Dennis added. "Because of her brain injury she lives with Spastic Cerebral Palsy."





Phase II plans are to have walking trails that wind

through the property from the Phase I parking lot, along Cox Creek, Cypress Creek, and return to the parking lot. It will provide public access to the rest of the recently purchased twenty-two acres providing a natural buffer for the Cypress Creek drinking water treatment plant. Medicare Minute

"Medicare Supplements"

Medicare supplements, also known as Medigap policies, are designed to help cover some or all of the deductibles, copays and coinsurance that Original Medicare does not cover. Medigap policies are sold through private insurance

In Alabama these insurance companies can sell you only a "standardized" policy identified by a letter, such as Plan F. The most common supplemental plans in Alabama are Plans A, B, F, G and N. The term "standardized" means that Medicare requires all plans with a particular letter to have the same basic benefits regardless of the company selling it. For example, a Plan G with one company has to have the exact basic benefits as Plan G with every other company selling it.

Two things to keep in mind when shopping for a Medigap policy. First is the premium. Different insurance companies can charge different premiums for the exact same policy. This means you could pay more for your Medigap policy from one company than you would from other companies offering the same basic benefits. It's a good idea to check with someone who can show you the premiums from several companies to be sure you're getting the best premium for you coverage.

The second thing to keep in mind is the type of Medigap policy you are looking at. Some companies offer a Medicare SELECT policy. SELECT policies may require you to use a defined network of providers to receive full coverage, meaning you may not have full coverage from a provider even though the provider accepts Medicare. A standard Medigap policy will allow you to go to any provider that accepts Medicare. If you are not sure about the type of Medigap policy you are looking at, or its premium, you can contact or come by our office for help.



were in charge.



I now love myself and nurture my own soul with what I learned from this long ago traumatic experience.

I pray a hedge of healing around those who are suffering losses new and

God takes his time in the healing process. You are not alone, were never alone, and will not ever be alone.

'Learn about me," God said. "I love you so much that I am giving you my son, and when He returns to me. I will send you a Comforter. Seek comfort in the unseen and your faith will become stronger.

When you are stronger you can téll others how you went through the fire and was not consumed and the waters and did not drown.'

We who remain are here for each other. Do not let life without a loved one destroy you, let your loss enrich your journey of faith.

This is not the end.

May God give us courage to face the days ahead in all situations with our faith in the unseen, and our love and compassion for each other. -Amen



Following an outbreak of the dreaded plague. smallpox (Variola), at Florence during the winter of 1865-66, the Board of Aldermen adopted a resolution on January 2, 1866, that a Pesthouse be "erected at the vineyard as soon as practicable." According to tradition, this Pesthouse, believed to have been a simple two-room log structure, was located in this area where people with infectious diseases could be isolated from the community. Also located nearby is a small cemetery where victims of these diseases were sometimes buried in unmarked graves.

Infectious illnesses plagued communities before the development of vaccines for smallpox and other diseases. During WWI, more died of the Spanish Flu than of warfare. As late as 1950, fifty million people died of smallpox worldwide. But widespread use of vaccines allowed the World Health Organization to certify the global eradication of smallpox in 1979.



Pray Without Ceasing

One morning an old farmer entered a fancy city restaurant and ordered his breakfast. When his food arrived he reverently bowed his head in prayer and thanked God for the blessing of what he was about to eat. Some of the other customers sitting nearby had seen the farmer praying and began to snicker. When he finished they asked him, "Old Timer, does everyone say their prayers where you come from?" "Nope," the old farmer responded rather calmly, "the pigs don't."

I don't think they had any more questions for "Mr. Farmer." He had answered them well! Prayer should be an integral part of our lives. The Bible teaches that we should "Pray without ceasing" (I Thessalonians 5:17). Yet, far too many of us fail to pray as we should. So, what is the problem?

For one thing, we are so richly blessed that maybe we take these blessings for granted and forget from whence they came. If so, James reminds us that we would have nothing without God. He penned, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father..." (James 1:17). Everything ultimately belongs to God and we are only stewards of whatever He has entrusted to our care. Thus, He deserves our continual prayers of thanksgiving!

Another thing to consider is, maybe we fail to realize the power of prayer. Our problems can seem so big and overwhelming at times that we are left feeling helpless and hopeless. If that is the case, then we can take courage in the following passage: "Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think..." (Ephesians 3:20). Paul teaches quite simply that God is greater than our problems and we should never feel that anything is beyond the scope of His power. In short, we should feel confident to pray about anything and everything- - at any time!

More could be said about why we do not pray as we ought, but these verses should provide enough proof to bring us to our knees on a regular basis. When we stop to consider how good and how great God is, then we can understand why not only a farmer, but all of us should "pray without ceasing."

I conclude with these invaluable words, "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:6, 7).





SAVE UP. OR GET A **MORTGÁGE?**

Dear Dave,

I'm 28, single, and I just became debt-free. In addition, I make \$70,000 a year and have the equivalent of six months of expenses set aside for emergencies. Should I save up to pay cash for a house, or is mortgage debt okay? I'd like to keep the price of a new home between \$200,000 and \$225,000. Since I currently live in a nice apartment, I think I can save about \$20,000 a year. What do you think?

Dear Kathryn,

Kathryn

It sounds like you're in great financial shape. Congratulations on becoming debt-free!

Let's take a look at both scenarios. If you can save \$20,000 a year, that means you're about 10 years away from a nice, paid-for homé, and you're still debt-free. That's one option. At the same time, I don't yell at people for taking out a 15year, fixed-rate mortgage, where the payments are no more than 25 percent of their monthly take home pay. In this situation, you

could save like crazy for a couple of years and make a big down payment on a home in the price range you're talking about. Then, you could pay off that house in just 15 years.

I honestly don't have a problem with either solution, Kathryn, but think about this. Wouldn't it be great to have your own home, and still be completely debt-free, at 40? It's something to think about!

STAND UP TO THEM!

Dear Dave,

A debt collection agency started calling my office a few weeks ago. I gave them an initial payment, and made an agreement to pay off the debt in monthly installments. This morning, they started calling me at my office again wanting payment. Can I legally demand they not call me at my place of employment?

James

Dear James, Absolutely! You have a legal and moral obligation

to pay your debts, and I'm glad this is something you recognize. But collectors have rules they must fol-low. They're governed by law just like everyone else.

Bé certain to keep your end of the agreement. Make your payments on time, or early, whenever possible. Then, if they call you at work again, remind them of your initial payment and the terms of the agreement already in place. Be polite, but firm, and demand that they never call you at your office again.

In addition, send them a certified letter, return receipt requested, so you'll have proof you sent the letter and they received it. In the letter, let them know that — according to guidelines set forth in the Federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act — you are demanding they not call you at your office again.

If they call you there after receiving this formal demand to stop, they'll be in violation of federal law. If that happens, let them know you'll talk to a lawyer and sue them.



Marines!" Junior Rangers will experience what life was like for a French Marine in 1736. At 1:30pm Mast will give a 30-minute talk about the Battle of Ackia from both the French and Chickasaw perspectives and the long-range impacts this battle had on European colonization of the area.

The Chickasaw prevailed over the French at the Battle of Ackia- known as Hikki'ya' by the Chickasaw near modern-day Tupelo on May 26, 1736. This victory prevented the further expansion of the French and eventually led to their defeat during the French and Indian War. Smith and Mast will share their knowledge of the time period with visitors of all ages through displays of Chickasaw life and French Marine equipment following the programs.

The Tombigbee Pioneer Group will also demonstrate pioneer-era crafts and skills at the visitor center from 10am-3pm. The presentations will show the challenges faced and creative solutions developed by those Americans who lived in the area during the early 1800s.

SELLING YOUR HOME

Have you ever said "well if it's not worth that I'll just keep it" or "It's not costing anything sitting there." Laughing yet? Unfortunately this price, the price you think it's worth, has no bearing on market value.

Price B: The price you need or want in order

Price C doesn't care how much the payoff is nor how much you need to clear, but the closer you are to price C, the faster your home will sell. -mr
