



# NO-CHURN BLUEBERRY CHEESECAKE ICE CREAM

#### **Ingredients**

1 cup blueberries

1 Tbsp. Water

1 cup sugar, divided

1 pkg. (8 oz.) Cream Cheese,

cubed, softened

1 cup Sour Cream

1/2 cup whipping cream

1 Tbsp. vanilla

4 graham crackers, broken into small pieces

#### **Directions**

Bring blueberries, water and 2/3 cup sugar to boil in small saucepan; simmer on medium-low heat 8 min. or until thickened, stirring occasionally. Refrigerate 30 min. or until completely cooled.

Process remaining sugar with all remaining ingredients except graham cracker pieces in food processor until well blended; spoon into 1-1/2-qt. freezer-proof container. Gently stir in graham cracker pieces. Top with spoonfuls of the blueberry mixture; swirl gently with spatula. Makes about 5 cups.

#### **BLUEBERRY SOUR CREAM POUND CAKE**

#### **Ingredients**

6 eggs, separated

1 cup butter, softened

3 cups sugar

1 teaspoon almonds extract

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 teaspoon butter flavoring

3 cups all-purpose flour

1/4 teaspoon baking soda

1 cup (8 ounces) sour cream

1-1/2 cups fresh or frozen blueberries

#### **Directions**

1. Let eggs stand at room temperature

for 30 minutes. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add egg yolks, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add the extracts and butter flavoring. Combine flour and baking soda; add to creamed mixture alternately with sour cream, beating well after each addition. In another bowl and with clean







beaters, beat egg whites on high speed until stiff peaks form. Fold into batter.

Fold in blueberries.

2. Spoon into a greased and floured 10-in. tube pan. Bake at 350° for 60-70 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack to cool completely. Yield: 16-20 servings.

#### **BLUEBERRY BANANA OATMEAL BAKE**

#### **Ingredients**

1-1/2 cups unsweetened almond milk or 2% milk 1/3 cup honey

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon 1/8 teaspoon salt


1-1/4 cups old-fashioned oats 2 medium bananas, sliced

1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries

#### **TOPPING:**

1/4 cup packed brown sugar 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour 2 tablespoons butter, softened 1/2 cup chopped pecans

**2.** Arrange banana slices in a single layer in a greased 9-in. square baking pan; sprinkle with blueberries. Pour oatmeal mixture over top, spreading evenly. Bake 25-30 minutes or until set. Remove from oven. Preheat broiler.

**3.** For topping, in a small bowl, mix brown sugar, flour and butter with a fork until crumbly; stir in pecans. Sprinkle over oatmeal. Broil 7-8 inches from heat 2-3 minutes or until lightly browned. Let stand 10 minutes before serving. Yield: 4 servings.





# BLUEBERRY

#### **BLUEBERRY UPSIDE-DOWN SKILLET CAKE**

#### **Ingredients**

1/4 cup butter, cubed

1 cup packed brown sugar

1/4 cup orange juice

1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries

1-1/2 cups all-purpose flour

1/2 cup sugar

2 teaspoons baking powder

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 large egg

1/2 cup 2% milk

1/2 cup butter, melted

1/2 teaspoon almond extract

Optional toppings: vanilla ice cream, whipped cream and toasted almonds

#### **Directions**

- **1.** Preheat oven to 400°. In a 10-in. ovenproof skillet, melt cubed butter over medium-low heat; stir in brown sugar until dissolved. Remove from heat. Stir in orange juice; sprinkle with blueberries.
- **2.** In a large bowl, whisk flour, sugar, baking powder and salt. In another bowl, whisk egg, milk, melted butter and extract until blended. Add to flour mixture; stir just until moistened.

Pour over blueberries.

**3.** Bake 18-22 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes before inverting onto a serving plate. Top as desired. Yield: 8 servings.

To toast nuts, bake in a shallow pan in a 350° oven for 5-10 minutes or cook in a skillet over low heat until lightly browned,

stirring occasionally.

#### BLUEBERRY LEMON TART

#### **Ingredients**

1-1/4 cups all-purpose flour

1/3 cup sugar

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup cold butter, cubed

1 egg yolk

2 tablespoons cold water

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

FILLING:

1 can (14 ounces) sweetened condensed milk

1/2 cup lemon juice

4 egg volks

4 teaspoons grated lemon peel Dash salt

TOPPING:

2 cups fresh blueberries

1/2 cup blueberry spreadable fruit

#### **Directions**

- 1. In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar and salt; cut in butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Whisk the egg yolk, water and vanilla; add to crumb mixture. Stir until dough forms a ball. Cover and refrigerate for at least 30 minutes.
- 2. On a floured surface, roll dough into an 11-in. circle. Transfer to a greased 9-in. fluted tart pan with a removable bottom; trim even with edge of pan. Place pan on a baking sheet.
- 3. Line unpricked pastry shell with a double thickness of heavy-duty foil. Bake at 375° for 15 minutes. Remove foil; bake 5 minutes longer.
- 4. In a small bowl, beat the filling ingredients; pour into crust. Bake for 12-15 minutes or until set. Cool on a wire rack.
- 5. For topping, microwave blueberries and spreadable fruit on high for 1-2 minutes or until bubbly around the edges; stir. Cool for 5-10 minutes. Gently spoon over filling. Refrigerate until chilled. Yield: 12 servings.

#### Claybank Master Gardeners

Now that our famous Alabama heat and humidity is upon us, remember your outdoor plants will need regular watering to stay healthy. Watch the leaves, you'll notice drooping or curling when they are thirsty. Try to avoid wetting the leaves, and water the soil just below the leaves. Watering the leaves in the afternoon and evening is an invitation to viral and fungal diseases. If you have automatic sprinkler systems, watering early in the morning before the sun gets high, will give the leaves time to dry off before nighttime dampness, and will help prevent diseases. Mulch the soil with pine straw or leaves, to help cool the root systems. Yellowing or curling leaves may be helped by spraying with Epsom salts (magnesium sulfate), one tablespoon per gallon of water. Magnesium strengthens the cellular structure of the plants. Sprinkle 2 tablespoons around the base of the plant for more protection. Google "Epsom Salt in the garden" for some more great tips. Free publications on home gardening are available from the Extension service. <a href="http://www.aces.edu/pubs/docs/">http://www.aces.edu/pubs/docs/</a> is an extension site for pdf documents on a huge variety of research-based gardening topics.






