New Business Gives Nod to Local History



KISHAWA? ...
Not KESHEQUA?

Local business woman Pam Washington and family named their new creamery after a historical pronunciation of the creek that runs through their family farm, which bears the same name, in Hunt, NY.

Many might be surprised to learn that the settlement of Hunts Hollow, outside Nunda, New York, was previously known as Kishawa. Historical reference tells us, * "The very stream that flows through our village and a former thriving hamlet near its source bore the name Kashawa for the stream, and also Hunts Hollow once bore the name Kishawa. The Senecas called it Cashaqua....Coshaqua was the form in early Gazeteers which was Anglicized into Cashaqua and finally it drifted back to Kashaqua or Keshequa or Kishaqua until it is hard to know how it ought to be spelled."

While working full time, Pam pursued her long-time interest in farming, and encouraged her daughter to find something she was really interested in as well. The choice was made to raise a dairy cow, which led to expansion into what to do with all the milk that cow produced, which in turn led to more animals on their farm and finally an idea to open a business with a connection to that farm. Pam attended Cornell University's Dairy Extension completing the Master Preserver course, Dairy Science, Dairy Sanitation and Vat Pasteurization. On weekends she attended local cheese making classes and selected evening courses at Genesee Community College in their Food Science program. In January 2018 she attended the world renowned Ice Cream Short Course at Pennsylvania State College. There she learned about all things ice cream, and enjoyed growing her support network of Ice Cream professionals and people at both the academia level and those who have experienced successful entrepreneurship in the ice cream industry.



Supporting the local community, family values, and instilling good work ethics in our youth are important factors and goals in running the business. Her entire family is a part of the team at the Kish-a-wa Creamery, as well as a staff of nine part time employees. The current Farm to Fork movement has peaked Pam's interest and could potentially be part of the future for the creamery. The Washington's believe that there is a need to support and appreciate our local agricultural community to ensure a healthy and growing community into the future, for all of us. They are looking forward to continuing to bring quality products to the area, and look to the future with an eye toward connecting agriculture back to their own local communities.

Pam and her family are very pleased with the support they have experienced so far from their customers and are looking forward to a very successful opening season! Next year, the potential for Kish-a-wa Creamery to begin making their own hard ice cream, begin a food establishment ... are all possibilities. Make sure you stop and visit Kish-a-wa Creamery and see the many ice cream favorites that are being offered! Check out some old time recipes that are on the menu, like a Soda Phosphate, a Brown Cow or a Dusty Road sundae. How about a new healthy alternative? A Strawberry-Banana Smoothie! May is Lyme Disease Awareness Month

Mount Morris, NY: - Lyme disease is a bacterial infection that can be spread to humans by the bite of an infected deer tick. Ticks can be hard to see, as they may only be about the size of a pin-head. Lyme disease cases peak in the summer months, especially during May, June, and July.

Lyme disease is very serious and can become crippling or debilitating if not properly diagnosed and treated with antibiotics. Typical symptoms include fever, headache, fatigue, and a characteristic skin rash called erythema migrans. If left untreated, infection can spread to joints, the heart, and the nervous system. Serious risks from Lyme disease can be reduced if the tick is removed within 36 hours.

Anyone who plays or works outside is at an increased risk. Ticks most commonly live in cool, moist environments, and can be found in tall grassy areas, garden areas, around shrubs and in wooded areas. The public can be at risk while mowing lawns, picking up leaves, or other outdoor activities. Deer, birds, mice, and other animals can transport ticks into your yard.

There are several things you can do to protect yourself and your family from tick bites. Below are some basic tips to follow:

- Keep your lawn mowed and cut down brushy areas.
- Avoid areas that may be infested such as, tall, grassy, moist areas.

- Use protective measures. If you know you will be walking in tall grass wear long sleeves and tuck your pants into your socks and shirt into your pants. Also, try to wear light color clothing so that ticks are more visible.
- Use repellent that contains 20 percent or more DEET, picaridin, or IR3535 on exposed skin for protection that lasts several hours.
- Perform a tick check on yourself, your pets and your children when finished with outside work or play.
- If a tick is found, do not apply mineral oil, petroleum jelly, or heat. Use fine-tipped tweezers to remove the tick. Contact your doctor if there are concerns about incomplete tick removal or if a rash or flu-like symptoms develop.

By following these guidelines, you can help protect yourself and your family from Lyme disease.



Respite provides caregivers with a break from their caregiving responsibilities. There are several options for respite care in Livingston County, including in-home care, adult day programs and social programs.

Home Away from Home Respite Center is located at the Interfaith Center, 11 Franklin St. in Geneseo. Caregivers can drop loved ones off at a safe and friendly environment. Program Coordinator and college students provide companionship, activities and socialization. Students receive training from the Alzheimer's Association. Hours are 10 am-2 pm, Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Arc of Livingston-Wyoming offers the Blended Seniors Program located at The Arc's Open Roads Senior Program on 66 Stanley St., Mt. Morris. Transportation is provided. Participants can engage in crafting, music, fitness and socialization, alongside individuals with intellectual disabilities. Qualifying seniors with Alzheimer's disease or dementia can attend for free 1-2 days per week, between the hours of 10 am-2 pm.
