# Have fun at June Fete Fair — all in support of first-rate health care

The June Fete Fair is a grand affair with a venerable cause at its heart. Beneath the surface of the three-day festival of food, fun, friendship and equine entertainment beats a 105-year history of charitable support for the essential work of Abington Hospital – Jefferson Health.

Held this year from June 8 through 10 at the June Fete Farm in Huntingdon Valley, June Fete is the premier annual fundraising event of the Abington Health Foundation Women's Board. The Women's Board provides significant charitable support for the people, programs, facilities, technologies and services that make Abington Hospital one of the region's top care providers.

## **An organization older than the hospital it supports**

More than 100 years ago, back when a local hospital in Abington was still just a dream, a new organization formed to make that dream a reality. In 1912, a dedicated group of local women initiated a campaign to raise funds for a hospital still in the planning stages. They organized an assortment of successful street fairs, lawn fetes and holiday bazaars to help pay for the linens, furniture and other supplies the hospital would need when it opened in 1914.

Building on their initial success, these enterprising women held their first Garden Party Fair in 1913 on the manicured

grounds of the Elkins Estate in Latham Park. That event became an annual fair and acquired the name "The June Fete" in 1918. A Pony Show was added in 1922 and a Horse Show in 1923.

## **Still funding excellent health care**

Today, the June Fete Fair is one of the region's oldest continuously run fairs. The Women's Board takes pride in maintaining the tradition of this annual community event, which now draws more than 25,000 people over the course of the weekend.

Most important, just like that very first garden party in 1913, today's June Fete still supports Abington Hospital's essen-

tial services for the community. However, both the size of the Women's Board and its charitable contributions have grown considerably over the past century.

Today, the impact of the Women's Board and Auxiliaries is felt throughout Abington as proceeds benefit everything from employee awards in support of continuing health care education, to facility construction and expansion, to equipment purchases, community programs, assistance for patients in need and much, much more.

So keep in mind, come that second weekend in June, when you participate in the June Fete Fair, you are supporting your community's health — and that's truly something to celebrate

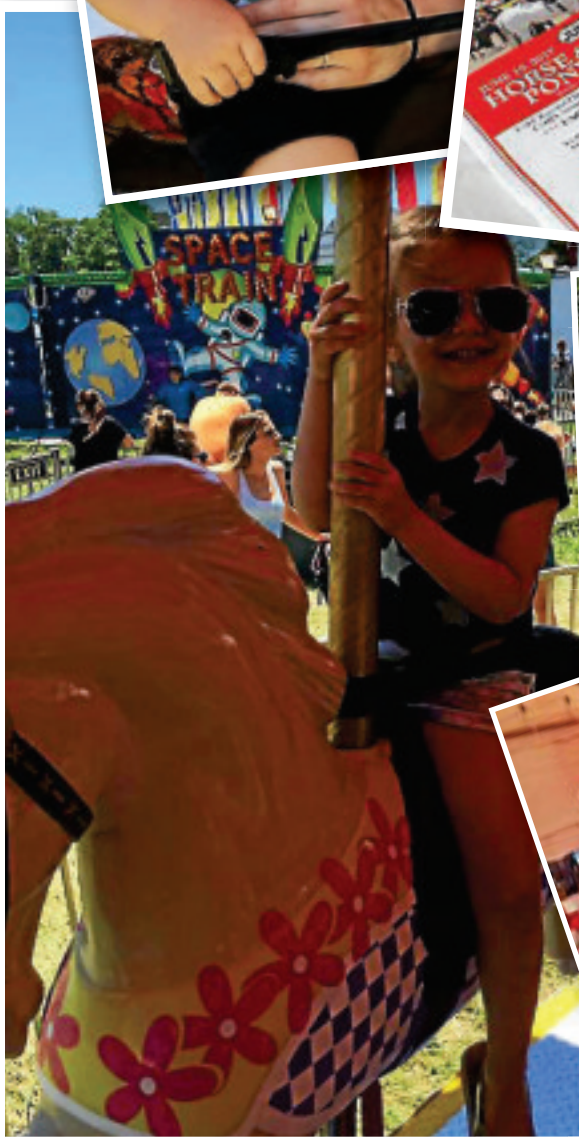

# Montgomery County 4-H Drill Team

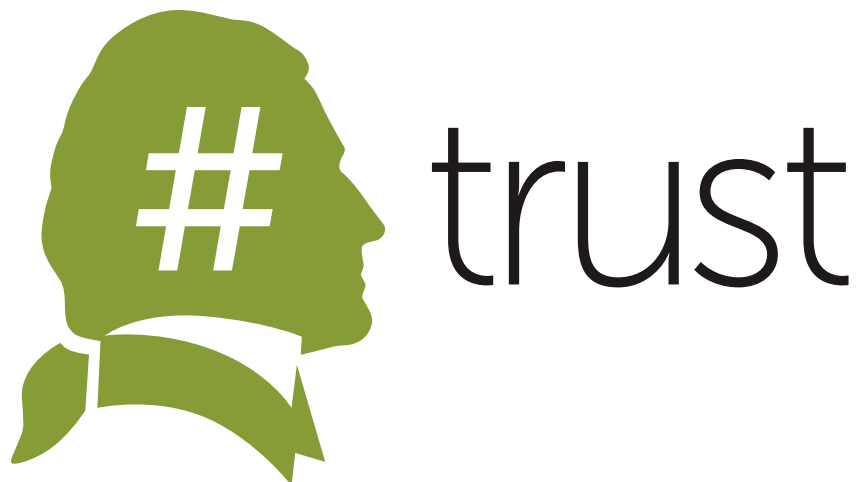
