

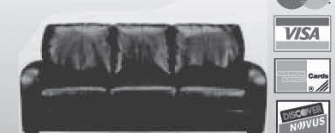

CATS AND GUNS

Uncontrolled cats are becoming a
negative issue for wildlife.

Now that's a weird combination for a title, isn't it? If you stop and think about it, they both seem to be causing a lot of problems lately, but it is not the cats or the guns, it's us! We let cats run loose or dump them off somewhere and we are very poor at keeping guns out of the hands of screwy people. Maybe if we got harsher with people who let their cats roam free or dump them, they would be less of a problem in our great outdoors. Maybe if we quit worrying about making tougher gun laws and just enforce what we have and stay alert for those weird-acting people there would be less problems with guns.

So what is the problem with free-ranging cats, especially feral cats? Well, they do a lot of damage to our wildlife. Especially birds and small mammals like baby rabbits and squirrels. They are simply following natural instincts, and it is estimated that feral or outside cats kill more than one-billion birds and billions more small animals a year. It is estimated that there are 80 to 90 million feline pets in the U.S. Scientists estimate that 60-70 percent of the cats get to roam outside uncontrolled.

One of the problems with these roaming cats is they are very effective killers, and many times they are just killing for sport and do not even consume what they kill. Even cats that live indoors and are well fed still kill for sport when they get out. Another problem is cats burying their feces in the neighbors' flower beds. Those folks can get infections from working those beds. Nesting birds, even if not caught, usually have their nesting season ruined by cats attempting to catch them.

So what is being tried today? One thing that cat advocacy groups have been pushing in recent years is the TNR theory (trap, neuter release). Common sense tells us this is not going to work, and scientists have proven it. For one thing, it is hard to trap and neuter enough cats to keep ahead of the population growth. They can't catch them all, and one fertile cat can have 12 to 18 kittens a year. Second, releasing them to free range solves none of the killing problems. These TNR colonies often become a cat dumping place for unwanted animals and may actually increase in size due to this dumping.

Speaking of dumping cats, I have noticed a real increase in the number of cats being dumped off at the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge the last couple of years. They can be deadly on birds like bluebirds and tree swallows nesting in the nesting boxes the refuge provides. Same old story - releasing them back into the "wild" makes the people feel better, but makes it rough on the wildlife and actually shortens the cat's life. Again, it is the people causing the problems with the cats just like with guns being used in violate crimes.

So what can be done? Well, for starters, let's make folks get a license for their cats just like we do with the dogs. This would also ensure they get their shots and help to contain the spread of stuff like rabies. Second, make the cat owner responsible for his or her animals and have them under control. Can you imagine the problems we would have if our dogs were allowed to be unlicensed and run free?

My son has a cat because in his situation it would be too hard to have a dog. His cat is very content and healthy and has never been outside. Another friend has about half a dozen cats and she has an outdoor kennel for them where they can get to it outside any time they want from a connecting cellar window.

Something needs to be done to start controlling the cat problem before we have more serious problems like diseases or other wildlife population lost. It has been proven that cats have been responsible for 26 percent of modern-day bird, mammal and reptile extinctions.

What about the gun problem especially at our schools? Maybe we could put up more stupid "GUN-FREE ZONE" signs to let the nutcases know where it is safe to go to not get confronted by other people with guns. Or maybe we could start getting serious about paying attention to people who are not acting normal. You can never get rid of all the guns just like you can't get rid of all the feral cats, but we can get more serious about paying attention to the folks who are causing both problems.

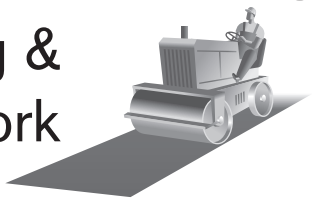

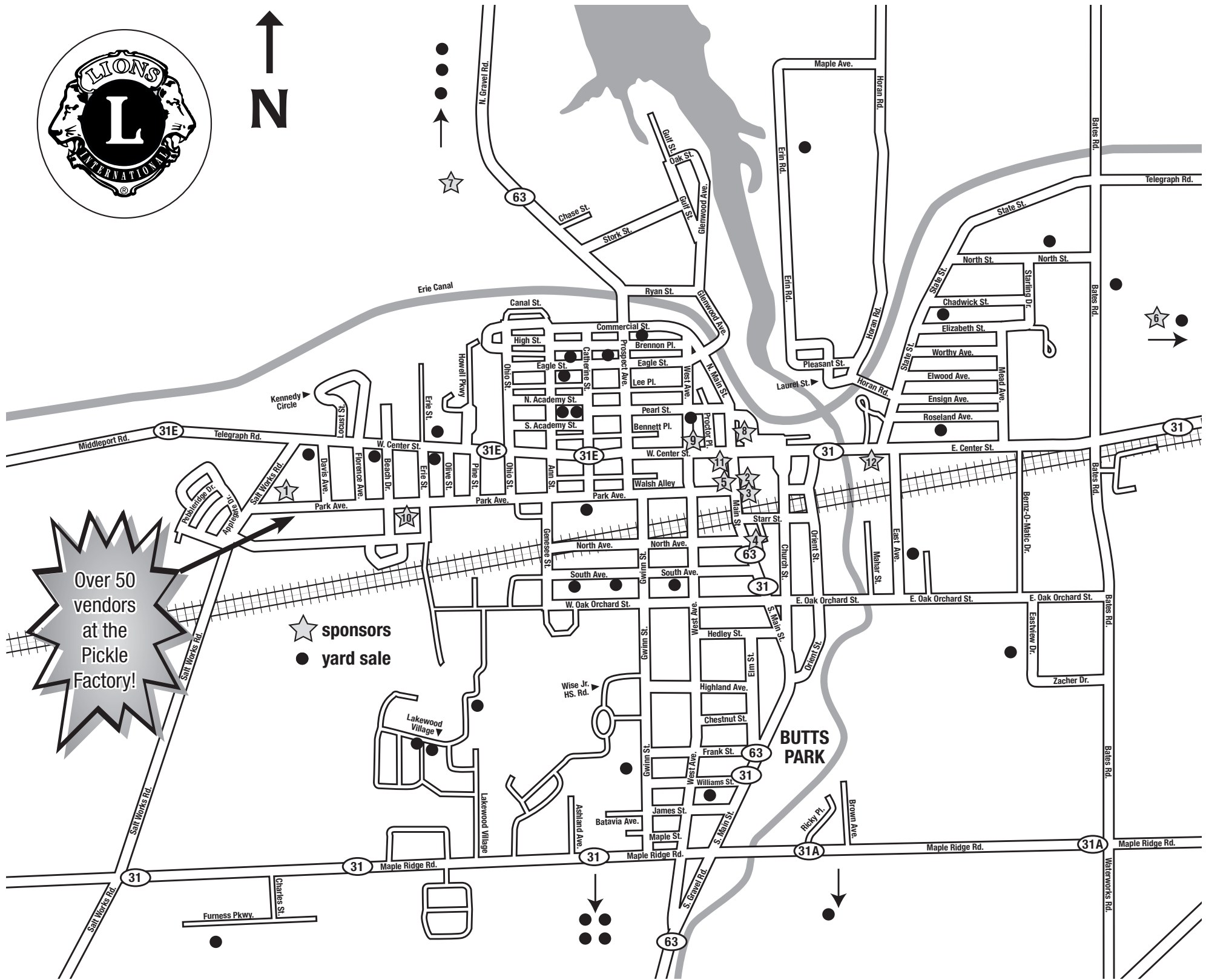

Cirrhosis

Cirrhosis is scarring of the liver that occurs when hard scar tissue replaces soft, healthy tissue in the liver. As cirrhosis worsens, the liver has less healthy tissue, and, when left untreated, cirrhosis can cause liver failure. Though cirrhosis can prove fatal, it is caused by chronic liver diseases that damage the liver over a long period of time, often several years. According to the American Liver Foundation, chronic alcoholism is the leading cause of cirrhosis in the United States. Overconsumption of alcohol can cause the liver to swell, eventually leading to cirrhosis. Chronic hepatitis C is the second leading cause of cirrhosis in the United States, and about one in four people with chronic hepatitis C will develop cirrhosis, which also can be caused by chronic hepatitis B and hepatitis D. Fat buildup in the liver not caused by alcohol consumption also can cause cirrhosis. Known as nonalcoholic steatohepatitis, or NASH, this often is accompanied by other health issues, including diabetes, obesity, high cholesterol, and coronary artery disease. Treatments of cirrhosis depends on the extent of the damage done to the liver at the time of diagnosis, but medication or lifestyle changes may be recommended. If cirrhosis has advanced to the point where treatment will prove ineffective, then a liver transplant may be necessary. ■

SIGNS OF A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1** Ask the person to **SMILE**.
- 2** Ask the person to **TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE**. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- 3** Ask the person to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.
- 4** Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

- Sudden **numbness or weakness** of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden **trouble seeing** in one or both eyes

- Sudden, **severe headache** with no known cause

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Symptoms include:

THE REAL DEAL

When it comes to making the largest purchase in their lives, home buyers should leave nothing to chance. Tips to Pay Off Student Debt Early

Recent college graduates may be entering the job market with degrees in tow, but many also are leaving school with sizable amounts of student loan debt. According to a 2017 report from the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, student loan debt rose for the eighteenth consecutive year, while Debt.org reports that student debt in the United States totaled \$1.4 trillion in 2017. Canadian students are not faring much better than their American counterparts, owing an average of \$28,000 after four years according to the Canadian Federation of Students.

Student loan debt is a heavy burden that has short- and long-term affects on borrowers. Sizable student loan debts may affect young professionals' ability to support themselves, while the Federal Reserve Bank of New York reports that such debt has contributed to a decline in the housing market, as fewer college graduates can afford to buy homes while still in their 20s.

The notion of paying off their student loans before they reach maturity may seem implausible to some borrowers. But there are a handful of ways for adults with sizable student debts to do just that.

- Make more frequent payments. Many homeowners pay their mortgages off early by making bi-weekly payments. Doing so means they will make 26 half-payments, or 13 full payments, each year as opposed to the 12 full payments made by homeowners who pay on a monthly schedule. The same approach can be applied to student loans. That extra annual payment each year can gradually chip away at loan balances, helping borrowers pay loans off before they reach maturity.

- Prioritize paying off high-interest loans. Many students finance their educations by taking out multiple loans. If these loans come with different interest rates, borrowers should pay off the high-interest loans first to reduce the amount they're spending on interest. Borrowers will still need to make minimum payments on other loans, but any extra money they intend to pay each month should go toward paying down the high-interest loan.

- Refinance loans. Many recent college graduates do not have lengthy credit histories, and some might be carrying low credit scores. Once such borrowers have shown that they can consistently make payments in full and on time, they can approach their lenders to refinance their loans in the hopes of getting a lower interest rate reflective of their creditworthiness. Refinancing may only be available to borrowers with private loans, but this strategy can save student debt holders a lot of money over the life of their loans.

- Take advantage of offers from lenders. Some lenders may reduce interest rates for borrowers who agree to certain terms, such as signing up to receive e-statements or enrolling in automatic payment programs in which money is deducted directly from a borrowers' bank account on the same day each month. The savings created by such offers may seem insignificant each month, but can add up over time.

Paying off student loan debts early can be done, even for borrowers whose debts are tens of thousands of dollars. ■

The Many Health Benefits of Dairy

Did you know that humans are the only adult animal species that continues to consume "milk" through dairy products. While most animals wean off of their mother's milk after infancy, humans across the globe have been consuming products produced by cow, sheep or goat milk for thousands of years. And the benefits can be numerous.

Human body grows to accept milk
 Although dairy doubters are quick to mention that it is not "natural" for humans to consume milk products into adulthood and that the body is not designed to digest the sugars and proteins in dairy, others are saying that centuries of farming have led to the evolution of human genes so that dairy products can be included in the diet.

According to a study published in 2013 in the journal Nature, archaeologist Peter Bogucki was excavating a Stone Age site in the fertile plains of central Poland in the 1970s when he came across various artifacts. One seemed to be an early pottery strainer used in cheese-making. The pottery was studied, and milk proteins were found on it.

As farming replaced hunting and gathering in many areas of the world, it's surmised that the human body slowly evolved to tolerate milk into adulthood, especially if it was fermented, such as in cheese or yogurt. Several thousand years later, it's believed that a genetic mutation spread through Europe that gave people the ability to produce lactase - the enzyme necessary to digest the lactose sugar in dairy - and drink milk. Many people who retain the ability to digest milk can trace their ancestry to Europe, according to a group of scientists brought together to work on a multidisciplinary project called LeCHE (Lactase Persistence in the early Cultural History of Europe). There are other dairy pockets from West Africa, the Middle East and South Asia.

Dairy's present-day benefits
 Today we know that dairy is an important source of nutrients at all ages and stages of growth. Southeast United Dairy Industry Association, Inc. says that dairy is a great source of protein, calcium, carbohydrates, phosphorus, potassium, and vitamins A, D, B12, riboflavin, and niacin.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture says that the calcium in dairy products is used for building bones and teeth and in maintaining bone mass. Diets with sufficient potassium may help to maintain healthy blood pressure. Additionally, vitamin D functions in the body to maintain ideal levels of calcium and phosphorus so that bones are built and maintained.

The Australian Dietary Guidelines say that consumption of milk, cheese and yogurt is linked to a reduced risk of heart disease, stroke, hypertension, type 2 diabetes, metabolic syndrome, and colorectal cancer.

The Dietary Guidelines for Americans encourage children and adults to enjoy three servings of low-fat or fat-free milk, cheese or yogurt each day. Canada's Food Guide recommends between three and four servings for children in the preteen and teenage years and two to three servings for adults.

Dairy can be a nutritious part of a healthy diet, and history suggests it has been for quite some time. ■

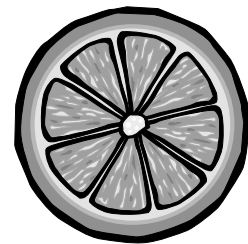
