REMINDER

When walking your pet in and around the Village it is prudent and required that you clean up after them appropriately.

Also, Local Law No. 1 of 2018, Providing for the Control of Dogs in the Village of Nunda; requires all dogs be "leashed" or "restrained by a leash" shall mean that a dog is equipped with a collar of sufficient strength to restrain the dog to which is attached a leash of sufficient strength to restrain the dog, and which shall be secured or shall be held by a person having the ability to control and restrain the dog by means of the collar and leash.
