its services in rural northwest Alabama with a new shelter after local supporter, 3M Company, announced a building donation. The facility can house up to 20 people and will provide an accessible location for victims in the area who now travel more than an hour to the closest shelter.

"Communities with local access to domestic violence services are more aware and responsive to the needs of victims," said Safeplace Executive Director Rachel Hackworth. "Agencies like Safeplace not only increase the capacity of their clients to regain self-sufficiency, but they also help break the cycle of violence in families."





Medicare Minute "Choosing a Medigap Plan"

Choosing the Medicare supplement, or Medigap plan, that's right for you can be a difficult task. On the other hand, Plan F is the "cadillac" of Medigap plans. Plan F will cover all deductibles, coinsurance and/or copays that is due after Medicare pays its part. Of course the premium for Plan A will be less than the premium of Plan F because Plan F gives you 100% coverage.

The most popular Medigap plan our company offers has been Plan G. Plan G covers everything Plan F covers except the Part B deductible of \$183. When talking to a company or agent about Medigap policies you may benefit by talking to someone who offers ALL the plans. Every company selling Medigap policies does not offer all the plan options. If you are speaking with an agent or company that does not offer a particular plan, such as Plan G, you may never hear about this plan.

THE JURY **SYSTEM**

The jury decides the facts and the judge decides the law. The role of the jury is to decide based on the testimony of the witnesses as given under oath in the courtroom. That means that a jury will decide disputed facts, the simplest of which may be which car ran the light. There are as many facts to be determined as there are lawsuits. Notice that this idea of testimony in front of a jury excludes "hearsay evidence." Hearsay is a statement by someone outside of court. There are exceptions but the idea is to let both sides examine the witness in person, under oath and with the jury present.

The judge decides what law applies to the case. When a jury hears the evidence, the judge tells the jury what the law is, based on what the lawyers and judge decide what law applies. When the lawyers can't agree, the judge decides what to tell the jury and the lawyers can, outside the presence of the jury, put on the record (for an appellate court to review) why they disagree.

In criminal cases the prosecution whether city, state or federal, must prove that the defendant is guilty "beyond a reasonable

doubt." We decided a long time ago that it's better to allow a criminal to be found not guilty than to convict an innocent person of a crime they didn't commit. Unfortunately, that happens anyway as we know from DNA evidence in cases where people were convicted that didn't commit the crime. All a jury can do is decide "guilty" or "not guilty." In Scotland, they have what I believe is a better system where a jury can return one of three verdicts, guilty, not proven or not guilty. I think that's more accurate.

In civil cases, a jury decides the facts based on "more likely than not." That is known as a "preponderance of the evidence." Always remember that a judge sitting without a jury determines the facts by applying the different burdens of proof. That is to say that in a criminal case, a judge

would have to find the evidence convincing "beyond a reasonable doubt" but in a civil case, a judge would only have to find the evidence "more likely than not" to rule in favor of a plaintiff.

It is the role of the jury to take differing testimony and determine whether it's more likely than not in a civil case or in a criminal case whether the testimony is beyond a reasonable doubt.



projects Art for students include activities geared toward each age group. Barb Hendricks's Experiments in Art will incorporate materials such as clay, cardboard, yarn and found objects into printmaking and lessons in color theory. Judges Enact Veterans Court

FLORENCE-The first Veterans Court for Lauderdale County will meet on Monday, January 7, 2019 at 3pm in Circuit Judge Will Powell's courtroom.

"Judge (Will) Motlow brought a case to my attention involving a veteran with severe PTSD, and together we helped get that veteran new housing, said Powell.

Veterans Court taps into that core discipline instilled in soldiers from their military training. Partnership with local veterans' groups are key. Local veterans act as mentors for each Veterans Court participant, so the Veterans Court team partnered with American Legion Post #11 in Florence. Some court sessions will even occur at the Legion Hall. This builds camaraderie and leads participants back to their brothers and sisters. By acting as mentors, fellow veterans help fill voids in participants' lives caused by self-destructive behavior.

Veterans Court will also provide advocates to help navigate the Veterans Administration or VA. They will help get participants any VA benefits they earned, especially medical or mental health treatment.

Two local attorneys volunteered. Kerrian Jaudon is already trained in VA advocacy, and Jamy **Poss** is an active member in the Alabama National Guard serving in the JAG Corp (military attorney).

The plan is to coordinate







\$500K Funded for YSP at NW

MUSCLE SHOALS -- The Youth Success Program (YSP) at Northwest-Shoals Community College (NW-SCC) has been funded \$500,000 for 2018-2019 by the Governor's Local Workforce Areas (GLWA).

Through the help of the YSP program twenty-three students received their GED or high school diploma, nine entered college, sixteen received a credential or certificate (YSP provided \$24,369 in book scholarships and tuition) and twentyseven obtained employment.

The Youth Success Program (YSP) at NW-SCČ serves out-of-school youth ranging in age from 16-24. YSP identifies and

assists those who have been unable to complete their education. It helps those who need guidance and assistance deciding between continuing their education and seeking additional training toward employment.

YSP offers services such as job skills/employment training, GED support, college enrollment assistance, tutoring and

mentoring.





ON YOUR DEBT

What Is "Confirmation" in Bankruptcy and Why Is It a Big Deal?

In a Chapter 13 Bankruptcy case, a lot of emphasis is put on getting your case "Confirmed" or having a successful "Confirmation" hearing. But what exactly is confirmation, and why is it so important? I'd like to take this blog to explain the confirmation process and why it's one of the most important but least well-known parts of Bankruptcy.

Confirmation Explained

Simply stated, confirmation is the process of getting your <u>Chapter 13 plan</u> officially approved by the Court. When you file a Chapter 13 case, you must also propose a plan for how you intend to repay your creditors. The plan lays out which creditors are going to get paid, when they can expect payment, and how much of their debt is going to be paid. After filing a Chapter 13 case, the Court will set a date for confirmation of your plan. This will typically be within 60 days of filing your case, and most courts will strive to confirm your case as quickly as possible.

Why Confirmation Is Important

Successfully confirming a case is one of the most important parts of your case. Until your case is confirmed, your creditors are only paid small amounts, called "adequate protection." They don't start to receive regular payments until your case is confirmed. So you definitely want your case confirmed so that the payments you make can go

where they are supposed to go.

Confirmation is also the first necessary step toward getting a discharge of your debts. Think of the Judge's Confirmation Order as a statement saying "As long as you finish the payment plan you've proposed, you'll be eligible for a discharge." If nothing needs to change after confirmation and you complete your payment plan, you'll be able to get a discharge of your debts without having to go back for any other court hearings.

The Process

Confirmation generally takes 60 days because your case can go through changes in the beginning months. During the period leading up to confirmation, your creditors will be filing claims to specify the type and amount of debts they are owed. The Chapter 13 trustee will also be reviewing the case to see if he or she needs any additional information or documentation as required by the Bankruptcy Code. The Trustee is also responsible for representing the interests of small creditors who may not find it cost effective to hire their own representatives to come to court on your case. If your plan doesn't propose fair treatment to a particular creditor or class of creditors, you can expect the Trustee to object.

It is normal for issues to come up during the confirmation period that may require you to file a new Chapter 13 plan Amendments are typically allowed prior to confirmation without too much difficulty. The Confirmation Order is what locks a plan in place. After confirmation, modifying your <u>lan</u> will take a lot more effort, including a hearing before the Judge and an explanation of why the Judge should allow you to change a plan he or she has already approved.



Dear Sheila,

No matter how little free time you think you have, or how fired you are, you must make time do a written budget every month. This is essential. 

News & Tips on the Shoals Market

PROS AND CONS OF MOVING THIS **SUMMER**

1. PRO: Interest rates and borrowing power. Unless you're paying cash, the mortgage interest rate will directly affect how much home you can afford. With rates continuing to creep up, and people predicting rates to exceed 5% in the next year, you may want to take a long look at how much more home you can buy at the lower interest rate. For example, let's say you can afford a (principal and interest) payment of \$1200 per month. A 30 yr loan at 4% interest with that \$1200 payment would mean a loan amount of \$251,353.49. Your loan amount at 5% interest would be \$223,537.94. So if you're calculating a 10% down payment, this means at 4% interest you're shopping for homes you might buy at \$279K. At 5%, you're shopping for homes you can buy for \$249K. That's \$30,000 less house for the same payment. (Note: Rates seem to be fluctuating in the 4's right now depending on the type of loan you're looking at, with 15 year fixed conventional loans as low as 3.875% as of last week.)

2. PRO: Low Inventory could mean a higher price for your home. Depending on the location and price range of your home, you might be surprised at how little competition you would have if you were to put your home on the market. While this is not across the board, it's amazing how hard it can be in certain areas to find a home for a buyer these days. This could mean that your home may bring a little extra money this summer and also may sell in a very short amount of time.

3. Con: Low inventory could mean a tough and competitive search ahead for your next home. Unfortunately, the same thing that may help you as a seller may hurt you as a buyer. Because of how competitive the market can be for buyers right now you just simply have to have a mindset to be committed to the process, be diligent in your search and be ready to act fast if you find the right home.

Obviously there are more pros and cons. Inventory, interest rates, and all of that other stuff can always be reasons to justify whether you should or shouldn't make a move. The real question I like to ask is, "How much will moving improve your quality of life?" Because that is a value that you just can't put a price tag on. -mr




