ANTICIPATING THE WORST

According to a recent AARP poll, only 36 percent of Americans have a living will, a document that outlines certain procedures that a person does or does not want to have performed under certain circumstances. For instance, some people do not want feeding tubes or respirators used to prolong their lives. A living will makes such preferences known in the event a person cannot communicate his or her desires. Moreover, since living wills cannot anticipate every circumstance, everyone is urged to give someone he or she trusts "durable power of attorney for health care." Doing so gives that person, known as the health-care proxy, the right to make medical decisions on behalf of the incapacitated person who gave the authority.

Wedding Costs: What to Expect

Newly engaged couples may experience an array of emotions when they sit down to plan their weddings. Some couples cannot wait to jump into planning and want to catalog every aspect of the process, while others may proceed with caution because they don't know what to expect - particularly in regard to cost.

Many couples find it difficult to create their wedding budgets because they have no previous experience to draw on. The wedding planning advisor CostofWedding.com indicates the average wedding cost in the United States is \$26,720, with most people spending between \$20,000 and \$34,000. Seventh Heaven Event Catering states that, in Canada, the average wedding costs around \$30,000. Such costs can vary greatly depending on couples' preferences, including where they hope to tie the knot.

By breaking down wedding expenses, couples can get a clearer picture of how much they may need to pay for their weddings and where they may need to cut costs.

- **Reception site:** According to The Knot, a premiere wedding planning resource, couples can expect their receptions to eat up the largest chunk of their wedding budgets. Wedding reception venues may cost between \$10,000 and \$15,000. The average price for catering per person is roughly \$70. Bar service may be around \$2,000 for a three- to four-hour party. Some reception sites combine the room cost with the food and beverage costs, while others have à la carte fees.

- **Cake:** Wedding cakes tend to be multitiered intricate designs, so they will cost more than birthday cakes. According to Statistics Brain, wedding dessert will come in around \$390.

- **Music:** The Knot says wedding bands cost around \$3,500, which is more than twice as much as hiring a deejay (\$1,200). Soloists or ceremony musicians may cost around \$650.

- **Wedding planner:** Many couples employ wedding planners to make planning their weddings easier. Wedding planners cost an average of \$1,300, says Thumbtack, a company that matches professionals with people who require their services.

- **Transportation:** Limousines and other transportation prices vary depending on the vehicle(s) couples choose. The Knot notes that budgeting between \$400 and \$500 for transportation might be wise.

- **Wedding gown:** Brides-to-be should expect their gowns to cost around \$1,100 and the veil or headpiece to be roughly \$120, according to the Association of Bridal Consultants.

- **Photography and Video:** Preserving wedding day memories costs around \$2,800 for video and photography services, based on data from Statistics Brain.

The smaller details, such as accessories, gifts, officiant fees, stationery, spa services, and favors can quickly add up as well. Couples should be sure to leave some wiggle room in their budgets for incidental expenses that may pop up. ■

NOT ONLY BEAUTY, BUT ALSO DANGERS

Learning to ID poison ivy is the first step
toward prevention.

As you all know, I have a tremendous passion for photographing nature and enjoy writing about it. However, everything in the great outdoors is not Disney World and I want to educate you on some of it today.

Let's start with my favorite - poison ivy! You may have heard it, "Leaves of three, leave it be!" But not touching it may not save you from the misery of having that horrible itching effect that gets spread all over your body and can even lead to an infection on your skin. The chemical on the poison ivy, urushiol, is an oil that causes the rash and can be easily transferred to pets, clothing, tools and footwear which can in turn be transferred to you. In fact, it can be transferred by the smoke produced by burning it. About 80-90 percent of folks can develop sensitivity to this chemical especially those of us who spend a lot of time in the woods and fields. Be aware if you are not sensitive to it now. That can change! This chemical is on the leaves, stems and roots and can be remain active even after the plant is dead and dried out.

A little story here. When I going to West Virginia University in dendrology class, we had an inside lab where the professor passed around dried-leaf specimens in Ziploc bags for us to examine. One of the students just couldn't resist opening one of the bags that contained poison ivy which had been in the bag for several years. Yep, he got it a few days later!

Poison ivy growing up trees and fences is often thought to be poison oak, but it does not grow in New York. There is also poison sumac, but it is very uncommon in New York being only found in certain types of swamps or flooded woods, and I have never seen any in our swamps here locally.

Having run around in the woods since I was a small child, I have had many dealings with poison ivy. As a young fellow I once had my eyes swollen shut by it for 3 days and once my left arm was so heavily covered by it that the forearm swelled up like an over-barbecued hot dog including the splitting of the skin.

The first defense against this horrid rash is being able to identify it so you don't get into it. With all the run-ins with it over my life I can almost smell it and my sixth sense often steers me around it! As mentioned before, the smoke from burning ivy is a terrible way to get it as is cutting it with a chainsaw when it is on a tree that is being cut up.

The second defense is to be careful of any tools that have been used around ivy, petting your dog or cat that has been running around outside (what's your cat doing running around lose outdoors?) or any other object that may have touched a plant. If I know I will be walking through ivy, hip boots are worn and then washed off later without touching the outside. In fact, if you think you have gotten into ivy, you should wash all your clothing or anything else you had that you may have gotten that urushiol on. Lukewarm soapy water should be used to wash any suspected places on your skin also.

In the last decade I have had good results with a skin cleanser call TECNU which you can get at the drug store. It will remove that urushiol from you skin and help it from spreading. It has also given me relief from itching although calamine lotion works well for the itching too. Just use it as soon as you can after you think you have been exposed. Even using just water, especially running water, as soon as possible after exposure will help and maybe prevent the terrible itching rash.

When I got that bad case around my eyes as a child, the doctor had my mother lay cotton pads soaked with baking soda water on them to help the itching, and I have heard that cucumber ground up into a mush and placed on the infected area also helps.

Using rubbing alcohol to wipe down an ivy-contact area will also cut down on the effect of the urushiol and may even prevent you from getting the rash. Something easy to carry if you think you will be getting into it while out there working or exploring.

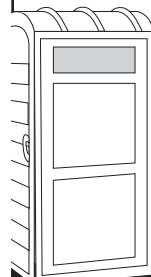
And no scratching, no matter how much it itches (try drug store anti-itching things like those mentioned above or even a cold pack which will help calm the itching). On the case where my arm swelled up like a hot dog and cracked, I got a good infection so don't treat a case casually, especially with small children.

There is another "monster" out there waiting for you so tune in next week to learn more.

Tips for Women Juggling a Family and a Career

Did You Know?

How households earn their income has changed dramatically over the last several decades. According to a Pew Research Central analysis of the Decennial Census and American Community Surveys integrated Public Use Microdata Sample files, in 1960 only fathers worked in 70 percent of American households. That figure has dropped in each ensuing decade and by 2012 fathers were the sole earners in just 31 percent of American households. While one in four households in American were dual income households in 1960, by 2012 that figure had risen to 60 percent. While those figures represent dramatic changes, the number of households in which mothers are the sole earners has not changed all that much since 1960. In 1960, mothers were the sole earners in just 2 percent of American households. Fifty-two years later 6 percent of American households featured mothers as the sole earners. ■
