#### Fish: The Perfect Dish for Father's Day

One of my favorite types of fish to prepare for my husband is tilapia. Tilapia is available year-round and can be grilled, broiled, fried, baked or steamed in the microwave. It cooks in less than 10 minutes, which makes it a tasty choice for a Father's Day dinner.

Tilapia, or "St. Peter's fish," is a living relic. There have been references to and drawings of a tilapia-like species dating to the time of the Egyptian pharaohs, and tilapia farming may predate the farming of any other fish species. Tilapia's mild taste, adaptability and relatively low cost have led to its rapid ascension as one of the top 10 seafoods consumed in the U.S. by volume.

The majority of tilapia farms are freshwater, although tilapia can survive in brackish water and even saltwater.

According to the Seafood Choices Alliance, the most commonly farmed tilapia species are Nile, Mozambique and blue. The skin color of the fish varies but is unrelated to flesh color or taste. Nile tilapia, known as nilotica or black tilapia, has dark skin. Mozambique tilapia, or red tilapia, has reddish skin.

Tilapia, as a plant eater, grows quite well on a grain-based diet. The use of fishmeal or oil from wild fish is therefore not required, although some farmers do add a small amount of fishmeal to their feed. Tilapia is available in graded sizes of 3-5 ounces, 5-7 ounces (most common) and 7-9 ounces. It tastes like the water in which it's raised, and the best quality tilapia has a very clean taste.

You can find whole tilapia or tilapia fillets in the seafood section of most grocery stores. This recipe for Buttermilk Pecan Tilapia is the perfect way to showcase this delicious fish on Father's Day!

2. In another bowl, combine the

breadcrumbs or cornflakes, ground pecans, paprika, cayenne pepper and the remaining poultry seasoning, salt and pepper. Mix well. Dip the fish fillets in the buttermilk mixture, then into the seasoned crumb mixture.

3. Place 2 tablespoons of oil in a large. non-stick pan and place over medium-high heat. Brown fillets in batches, 2 to 3 at a time — do not crowd the

pan. Cook 3 minutes on each side or until fish flakes easily when tested with a fork. Repeat with the remaining oil and fillets. Serve immediately. Serves 6 to 8.

TIPS: Poultry seasoning typically contains sage, thyme, marjoram and rosemary, all of which are delicious as a seasoning for fish. The buttermilk helps the coating to adhere to the fish. If you don't

A Wrinkle in Time (PG-13) — A brilliant scientist (Chris Pine) has found the key to interdimensional travel, but goes missing mid-experiment, leaving his smart and tough young daughter Meg (Storm Reid) adrift. Meg's precocious brother Charles Wallace (Deric McCabe) makes contact with a charming trio of celestial mentors - Mrs. Whatsit (Reese Witherspoon), Mrs. Who (Mindy Kaling) and Mrs. Which (Oprah Winfrey) — who inform the kids that their dad is imprisoned by an evil force known as The It that is threatening the entire universe. Meg, Charles Wallace and the Mrs.'s are joined by Meg's school crush on a journey that will test the limits of belief and love in

order to rescue their father.

Death Wish (R) - An unassuming emergency-room doctor (Bruce Willis) goes berserker when his home is attacked, his wife killed and his daughter put into a coma. Police incompetence enrages the good doctor, who sets out to make things right with his own brand of justice. It's not too long before his antics get caught on viral video, and he's dubbed "The Grim Reaper." A cautionary tale for criminals, he works his way through the list of lowlifes who have done his family wrong. It's not deep on story intricacies so much as it's an excuse for creative payback scenarios. In the end, the 1974 Charles Bronson original was better, but for a Friday night shoot-'em-up, Bruce Willis still delivers.

Gringo (R) — David Oyelowo portrays Harold, a pharmaceutical company representative, Nash Edgerton's comedic crime story set in Mexico. He's on a business trip to a crime-ridden city dealing as a straight arrow

with criminals and is mistaken for the company president and therefore subject to repeated kidnapping attempts. Somehow, he muddles his way through it all - or maybe he's the one setting this clockwork caper in motion. The problem is, the parts of this machine are too intricate to figure out, and the many-layered storylines (the hijinks of Harold's slick bosses, played by Joel Edgerton and Charlize Theron; a pair of happy-go-lucky drug mules, played by Amanda Seyfried and Harry Treadaway; a cartel that can't shoot straight) don't make it any easier.







#### Primitive Drying Rack

Our ancestors were clever and could make many tools, containers and cooking utensils from wood or iron. It was not until the mid-19th century that helpful gadgets like iron apple peelers with gears or other complicated tools were invented. Hundreds of patents were issued for improved household inventions. But during the 17th century and in rural areas, talented wood craftsmen created one-of-a-kind utensils for home use. Bowls, scoops, baskets, ladles and boxes were carved from wood harvested from nearby trees. The shape of the tree sometimes inspired the work.



This strange wooden carving is an early drying rack that was handmade from a single branch. Collectors of primitive pieces bid it up to \$6,500. It measures 17 by 11 inches

At a recent Skinner auction, a wooden drying rack was auctioned. It was made from a single large branch with five upright "rods" for holding the drying fabrics. The largest branch had a hole at the top where it could be hung from a nail on the wall. It was primitive, but useful. The drying rack, made in the 1700s, sold for \$6,500, because it was such an unusual relic of the early days of do-it-yourself tools.

I have a Cracker Jack AM radio my dad gave me when I

was 8 years old. It runs on a 9-volt battery. It's in perfect condition and tunes in clearly. Is it worth anything?

A Cracker Jack was first made in 1896 by Rueckheim & Brother. The company became Rueckheim Bros. & Eckstein in 1902. Prizes were included in the packages beginning in 1912. Cracker Jack radios like this were made in the 1970s in Hong Kong for Just Products, a New York company. They sell for about \$25.

• I would like to know what a set • of silver teaspoons is worth. The set has been in my family for more than 140 years. My great-great-grandmother received it as a wedding present from family in the Netherlands, and it has been passed on from generation to generation. One teaspoon and the sugar spoon both have "EPNS" on the back.

A • The initials "EPNS" stand for electroplated nickel silver," and mean your teaspoons are silver-plated, not sterling silver. Your set of teaspoons has great sentimental value, but not much monetary value. Silver-plated flatware is hard to sell, and it is not worth as much as sterling silver.
