In order to create some new programs, expedite adoptions, and give the old shelter a freshening up, the shelter will be closed to animal intake from Saturday, June 23 -Wednesday, July 4. ANIMALS CAN BE ADOPTED during this time. Animal Control will respond to priority calls only. It will re-open to full service on July 5. Details are in a letter to the editor in this issue.







My wife and I always look forward to taking a few days for "R&R" which is good for us in more ways than one. Not only is the trip enjoyable, it also helps to revitalize us so that we are more productive when we get back home. This is a "good" side of vacationing, but there is yet another side to consider.

Sometimes vacations are referred to as "getting away from it all." I think I know what is meant, but the truth is we must not leave everything behind. Case in point, we do not go on vacation from our spiritual obligations. When we wear the name "Christian" it means that we are committed to Christ 24/7 wherever we might be. Apparently, some folks take the stance that what they do "out of town" doesn't matter. That attitude reflects a "bad" side of vacationing, because our actions always matter!

First of all, what we do, whether in town or out of town, matters to God. To prove this point, Paul penned these stern words: "Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap" (Galatians 6:7). Secondly, how Christians conduct themselves, wherever they are, has an impact on others. Thus, letting our guard down can cause us to become a stumbling block to someone else.

For example, I once knew a man who had become unfaithful in his service to the Lord. The reason he gave for his unfaithfulness was his disappointment and discouragement of a former boss who was very active in church at home- - but would frequent the bars when on trips out-of-town. That man has passed from this life now but sadly, to my knowledge, he never made a spiritual recovery.

Every time I think of that man I am reminded of Jesus' teachings about the impact of "spiritual vacations" which He calls "hypocrisy." Note His words: "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in" (Matthew 23:13).

So, as you see, the damage of bad (spiritual) vacations can be tremendous in our relationship with God and others. Therefore, my word of encouragement to all is: Have A GOOD Vacation!

AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE COVERAGES

Because Joel and I have developed a personal injury practice that consists of suing insurance companies for personal injury, we often are asked questions about different types of insurance coverages.

We find that most people are unsure of what their car insurance covers and what triggers that coverage. The following is a list of common coverages with an explanation as to how those coverages generally apply.

<u>Liability</u> coverage is coverage for another person or automobile damaged as a result of your carelessness. Liability coverage is

purchased for a specific car and that coverage generally follows that car. It is mandatory in Alabama.

Collision coverage is insurance to repair your car if you collide with another object whether or not it is your fault. Often our clients will have collision coverage and a car damaged through someone else's carelessness and if that person has no insurance, or their insurance disputes or "investigates", then your collision will pay to have your car repaired.

Compreĥensive coverage is similar to collision and covers your car in the event of fire, theft, glass breakage regardless of fault.

<u>Uninsured motorist</u> coverage follows both the car and the driver for personal injury. In other words, if an uninsured driver injures you or someone in your car and you have uninsured motorist coverage then that coverage would pay for your medical bills, pain and suffering, loss of wages, etc. If you are in someone's else's car and they have uninsured motorist coverage and you are injured by an uninsured driver then you are covered from the car you are in and if you and your spouse have two cars at home, then you have two more uninsured motorist coverages available to you depending on the severity of the injuries, for a total of three policies, usually for

Medical payment coverage is coverage for your medical bills arising out of the use of the insured automobile without regard to fault for the occupants of the insured vehicle. Medical payment coverage is typically purchased in increments of \$1,000; \$5,000 and \$10,000. I think medical payment coverage was originally designed to pay health insurance deductibles and out of pocket expenses, however, hospitals now want to know not only who your health insurance coverage is with, they now want to know who your automobile insurance is with. They will bleed this coverage dry. If you have health insurance coverage, don't tell the hospital who your car insurance is with so you can use your medical payment coverage for deductibles and other out of pocket expenses.





Medicare Minute

"Frequently Asked Questions"

We began in the Medicare business in 2009. Since that time we have been asked some interesting and unique questions about Medicare. However, the majority of the questions we are asked we get on a regular basis. Over the next few weeks we are going to discuss some of our most frequently asked questions.

Do I have to sign up for Medicare Part B when I turn 65 if I'm still employed? This is one of the questions we get asked the most. In most cases the answer to this is "no". When you turn 65, if you are still working and on your employer's health insurance plan you probably will not need Medicare Part B. I say probably because most employer plans do not file on Medicare if you have a claim. Because you have to pay a premium for Part B, Medicare does not require a person to sign up for Part B as long as you are on your employer's plan. Once you retire the rules may change. The safest thing to do is check with the benefits coordinator at your place of employment for guidance or give us a call at our office.

I am on Medicare and Social Security Disability. I'm turning 65 soon. What are my options? Once you reach the age of 65 you have many more options than before. As you know if you go on Medicare and you are under the age of 65 your options for health plans are limited. When you turn 65 you will have another open enrollment period to sign up for any plan you wish to get. In other words, just because you are already on Medicare does not prohibit you from having all the options a person not on Medicare and turning 65 would have.

I'm sorry for your loss. I'm sorry, too, ábout what happened


with your father. I can't imagine the mixed emotions you must have in your heart. When someone asks me a

When is the right time to buy a house when someone is following your Baby Steps plan? Samuel

Dear Samuel,

That's a good question. Let's start by going over the first few Baby Steps.

Baby Step 1 is saving \$1,000 for a beginner emergency fund. Baby Step 2 is paying off all consumer debt, from smallest to largest, using the debt snow-ball. Baby Step 3 is where you increase your emergency fund to the point where you have three to six months of expenses

Once you've done all you can, begin saving for a homé. I'll call it Baby Step 3b. For folks looking to buy a house, I advise saving enough money for a down payment of at least 20%. I don't beat people up over mortgage debt, but I do advise them to get a 15-year, fixed rate loan, where the payments are no more than 25% of their monthly take-home pay. Doing it this way may take a little more time, and de-lay your dream of becoming a homeowner a bit, but buying a house when you're broke is the quickest way I know to turn

blessing into a burden!



FOUNDING OF FLORENCE


March 1818

February, 1818. On March 12, 1818, recognized as the Founding Day for Florence, Alabama, the Articles of Association was signed by the seven trustees of the newly-organized Cypress Land Company. It was organized for the purpose of establishing a new town that would become the county seat for Lauderdale County. This town was to be at the foot of the Muscle Shoals and the head of navigation on the Tennessee River. The signing took place in the Huntsville office of the federal surveyor for Northern Alabama, General John Coffee, The seven trustees were: Thomas Bibb John Childress, John Coffee, James Jackson, John McKinley, Dabney Morris, and Leroy Pope. Coffee, James Jackson, John McKinley, Dabney Morris, and Leroy Pope. Coffee, James Jackson and McKinley settled here later. Coffee assumed the role as leader of the trustees and principal developer of the new town, while all seven trustees became known as the Founding Fathers of Florence. The first action of the new company was the purchase of 5.515.77 acres of land for \$85,235.24 or \$15.45 per acre, at the land sales in Huntsville. To raise the down payment of \$21,508.81, twenty-five percent of the purchase price, the frustees sold 408 shares of stock a \$52.23 per share. This large tract of land provided for all possible sites for a new town between Campbell's Ferry, near present-day Wilson Dam, to Cypress Creek. At that time, Florence was an isolated hilltop in the wilderness overlooking the Tennessee River.

HISTORICAL MARKER LOCATION: Corner of North Court and West Tennessee Streets

To celebrate the 200th birthday of Florence, AL, a marker was installed on March 12 by the city's Bicentennial Committee to commemorate the "Founding of Florence." Both sides of the historical marker contain much information which is better read at its location on the corner of North Court and West Tennessee Streets in front of the Court House Annex. We had an average of 250 animals in the shelter each day last week. This is twice our capacity.

We are committed to providing humane care to all the animals in our shelter. We are going to implement some new programs, expedite adoptions, and give our poor old shelter a freshening up.

In order to do that, the Shelter will be closed to animal intake from Saturday, June 23 -Wednesday, July 4. It will re-open on Thursday, July 5. During that time, Animal Control will respond to priority calls such as a stray animal, injured animal, or aggressive animal. All others will need to take a recess during that time period.

This building is old and worn out, but it does not have to be dirty. We are going to clean it up inside and outside.

During the time it is closed, animals will be available for adoption and we will waive the fees, if necessary, to find homes for as many dogs and cats as possible. Our maximum manageable number of animals is around 125.

Please be patient with us as we work to provide the humane operation that our citizens and animals deserve.

• We are going to insure that every adoptable animal is photographed and posted in every medium possible to promote adoption.

• We are going to aggressively promote spaying and neutering throughout the city and county.

• We are looking for speaking engagements and other opportunities to promote animal services, adoption, fostering, spaying and neutering.

• We ask our community citizens to consider adopting an animal or consider becoming a foster to one or more animals. Staff members and volunteers can help explain how to become a foster.

I take this opportunity to thank the employees of the Animal Shelter for their hard work, their compassion for animals, and their commitment to a humane operation.

Thanks also to the volunteers who also share their compassion for animals and work hard on behalf of this facility. We could not do this without their help and commitment.

Can You Work and Still Draw Social **Security Disability Benefits?**

How So?

Just because you are drawing Social Security disability benefits doesn't mean that you are completely unable to work. The devil is in the details though. The catch is that while you cannot work full time, you can work part time as long as you do not make too much money. How much is too much you ask? Well, the Social Security Administration (SSA) has this concept called Substantial Gainful Activity it uses in Disability Insurance Benefits (DIB) cases to determine if a recipient is making too much money to still be considered disabled.

Our office handles two different types of SSA disability cases. They are as follows: DIB and Supplemental Security Income (SSI). DIB benefits are tied to what you have paid into the system while SSI benefits are needs based. I am going to focus on the impact working may have on DIB benefits only and save what impact working may have on SSI benefits for another day.

Working While Receiving DIB Benefits

For DIB recipients who are blind, the monthly work-related income limit is \$1,970 per month for 2018. For those receiving benefits for the rest of the disabling ailments the income limit is currently \$1,180 per month. We usually advise our clients who are able to work somewhat not to get too close to these limits though, as it is easy to slip up and endanger their benefits by miscalculating how much they are actually earning. If they do cross the line, they risk the possible termination of their monthly monetary benefit or having to pay it back through a substantial deduction in each month's check.

That being said, the SSA does have a program designed to help people get back to work full time if they are able without penalizing them during their attempt. It's called the Ticket to Work Program. Once an applicant is accepted into the program, it essentially allows them to explore their ability to hold down a full time job and earn more than the SGA limit without forfeiting their monthly monetary benefit. Of course, there are a raft of rules and regulations to adhere to as with any government program, but it may be worth it to see what kind of work you may be able to handle these days.

When Everyone Is On The Same Page...

"The best way to avoid a misunderstanding is to have a good understanding.

I heard this phrase some time ago and remind myself of it almost daily. Some of the biggest problems that arise in a real estate transaction can single handedly be tied to a misunderstanding between the two parties involved or their REALTORS who represent them. In the real estate business, you can't stress enough the importance of making sure everyone involved is on the same

This is why it is best to make offers, request repairs, agree to repairs and enter into any other agreement in writing rather than verbally. Does this mean that you shouldn't listen to a verbal offer? Of course not, but be sure that you understand all of the terms involved, not just the price. You should also be sure everybody understands that whatever is agreed upon verbally is subject to seeing all of the terms and conditions in writing.

One of the most common areas where a misunderstanding can take place in a real estate transaction is the negotiation of repairs based on an unsatisfactory home inspection. For example, if the inspection report reveals that a window in the hall bath has lost its thermal seal, the buyer wouldn't ask the seller to "fix window," the buyer may ask the seller to "replace the glass in the window in the hall bath," or whatever it is they want them to do specifically. The word to remember here is "specific." You always want to be very specific in any request you make.

Another great example would be asking the seller to pay the buyer's closing costs. You wouldn't ask "Seller to pay closing," instead you would be very specific and ask "that the seller pay the buyers closing costs up to but not to exceed \$2500.00" and even further, you'd specify whether or not this includes prepaid items such as homeowners insurance.

We all have busy lifestyles and an always on the go mentality. If you buy and sell property more than once you almost always find yourself negotiating at least some portion of a deal verbally, even moving a closing date or time for example. Always be sure you fully understand what you are agreeing to. Don't be afraid to ask questions to clarify if necessary. Have a good understanding of every detail and don't assume anything and you'll avoid frustrating misunderstandings. -mr
