



Grilled Pork Chops With Mango Sauce

A smoky, but still sweet, mango sauce adds brilliant, sunny color and a kick of flavor to these simply grilled pork chops

- tablespoon vegetable oil
- small (4- to 6-ounce) onion, finely chopped
- chipotle chile in adobo, seeded, finely chopped teaspoon dried oregano
