





Morgan Sullivan, a student enrolled in the Auto Body program at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center got a chance to show off her airbrushing skills.

I-CAR is an international not-forprofit organization dedicated to providing the information, knowledge and skills required to perform complete, safe and quality repairs. They approached her teacher, Tom Struebing, to see if any of this students would be willing to help

them out by painting miniature car hoods for a golf fundraiser they do every year. "It's a pretty big deal because people come from all over the country and this year it will be held in Atlanta. The hoods were going to be prizes for the golf tournament."

I-CAR sent four of the miniature hoods and Morgan was the first person Mr. Struebing thought of to help. "She is very artsy and told me the main reason she took my course was to learn how to airbrush. The criteria was that they should reflect golf, but something with the automotive industry because that is what we are. She got all four of them done and they look really good," he says with pride. "She used the names of the sponsors for the brand names of the golf balls. That worked out real well. She has placed pretty high in airbrushing competitions and I think this just validates her decision to come to the program."



"ABANDON" WILDLIFE BABIES

This is the time of the year that the young of wildlife begin to show up. Last week there were several baby gray squirrels running around outside our house. They looked cute, acted dumb and were very playful,

doing things that could make them dinner for a free-ranging cat or dog. It seemed like they has been abandoned but in reality they were just out of the nest cavity raising heck while Ma was out feeding somewhere.

The fawns of the white-tailed deer will be showing up now and it is not uncommon for folks that spend a lot of time in the woods and fields to run across one. Their first few days after being born they just lay still and try not to draw attention to themselves. The doe stays away from the fawn only going to it to let it nurse, usually three or four times a day. Although the fawn can stand and "kinda" run he is still pretty easy prey for a predator such as a coyote or dog. Thus by staying away from the fawn except to nurse it she cuts down the scent location of the fawn and the chance of a predator finding it. The fawn counts on his camouflage to keep him hidden and remains motionless when danger is near. It always amazes me how well they can blend into their surroundings. Many times I have nearly stepped on one because he was almost invisible and remained motionless.

This is the time period when people occasionally find a fawn and think it is abandoned and want to take it home and care for it. BIG MISTAKE! His mother IS nearby and the handling of it or the presence of people around the fawn could attract predators or cause his mother to stay away too long for its well being.

After about two weeks the fawn begins to travel with the doe and is in much better shape to avoid predators.

Yes, fawns are cute and often seem abandoned at times, but human interference could cause their death, so IF YOU CARE, LEAVE IT THERE.

Another animal folks will sometimes find and think is abandoned are baby raccoons. Like young squirrels these young raccoons will often come out of their dens (usually in a hollow tree) and play. Sometimes one falls or gets too far from the den and a person seeing it thinks it needs help. However his mother is near by and will find him and return him to the den.

Young raccoons are very cute and people think they would make good pets. However, like all wildlife, they can never be trusted and can get nasty for no reason and hurt someone. Another concern, especially with raccoons are diseases. It is possible that the mother is sick, such as with rabies, and has passed it on to those cute little guys. Thus you could contact rabies by handling them and not even know it until it is to late to get the shots for it.

So if you run across a fawn, young squirrel, raccoon or any other wildlife baby, just admire them from a distance and then guickly leave the area so the mother can return to care for it. And remember it is illegal to have a wild animal in captivity or as a pet and you could receive a stiff fine.



How to Save on College Housing Costs



College is expensive, and the costs are only rising. Scholarships and grants can help mitigate the costs of higher education, but even students who receive such aid could find themselves scrambling for ways to make college more affordable.

Housing is one of the more expensive costs for college students and their families. According to the College Board, the average cost for room and board during the 2016-2017 school year was \$10,440 at four-year public schools and \$11,890 at private colleges and universities. And those costs typically cover housing for just the school year, which may last anywhere from six to eight months. However, there are ways for students and their families to reduce those costs.

- · Examine your dormitory options. Many schools assign students to dormitories for their freshman years, giving students little say with regard to where they will live. However, students might have more input in their housing come their sophomore, junior and senior years. Some dorms might be more attractive and offer more amenities than others, but students and families looking to save money on housing costs should opt to live in the most budget-friendly dorms available to them. In addition, choose to live with a roommate rather than in a single room, as singles tend to cost substantially more than double rooms.
- · Sign up to be a resident advisor. Resident advisors, or RAs, often receive free housing in exchange for living in dormitories when they are upperclassmen or graduate students. RAs help newly enrolled or younger students adjust to campus life while also ensuring nothing untoward happens on the floors they're tasked with looking after. Students who may want to apply for

RA positions should first confirm if serving as an RA will affect their overall financial aid package and how great that impact

- · Live with roommates even after leaving the dorms. Due to limited space, many colleges insist dorm residents live with roommates. Upperclassmen who are moving out of the dorms and into university or off-campus apartments can save money by continuing to live with roommates. This can be especially beneficial to students who will be living in off-campus housing where amenities such as electricity, cable television and water are unlikely to be included in the cost of the rent.
- · Commute to school. While it might not be ideal, commuting to school can save college students and their families substantial amounts of money. Public university students who did so during the 2016-2017 school year might have saved nearly \$11,000, or \$44,000 in four years. That's money that can be used to pay tuition or finance postgraduate educations.

College housing costs can be considerable. But budget-conscious students and families can save on such costs in various ways.

For example, if \$200 in proceeds are collected, the winner of the raffle receives \$100. These types of raffles are popular fundraisers and don't require any special skills for entry. Few people expect to strike it rich when they enter a 50-50 chance. However, in July of 2014, Edmonton Eskimos fan Connor Croken won one of the largests jackpots in 50-50 sports raffle history, leaving an Eskimos game with \$348,534 Canadian (\$322,216 US) in his pocket. The remaining funds were earmarked to fund amateur football in the province of Alberta.
