Mississippi Main Street announces 2018 award winners

The Mississippi Main Street Association (MMSA) celebrated achievements of Mississippi Main Street Communities at the 29th Annual Awards Luncheon in downtown Jackson. MMSA Board President Ed Gardner, MMSA Past President Allison Beasley, and MMSA staff presented awards to recipients from local Main Street programs throughout the state. The annual awards luncheon honors Main Street directors, board members and volunteers and recognizes the most outstanding downtown development projects from Main Street communities in Mississippi.

Laurel Main Street was well represented at the awards luncheon, as four local residents were among the 2018 recipients accepting awards. They are as follows:

*MAIN STREET HERO – This award recognizes one outstanding community leader or public figure who has displayed an involved commitment to downtown and his or her Main Street program.

It is currently full with two retail stores, a co-working space, the offices for an engineering firm, and a restaurant. *OUTSTANDING **COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION** – This is an overall award that goes to a Main Street program that has achieved a successful, preservation-based downtown revival.

Winner (Medium Size town): Laurel Main

How do you bring a town back? It's a question that has no easy answers, and the answers that are given usually require years and more work than one might ever imagine. However, for Downtown Laurel, there is no question that the town has been revived in a powerful way. A stream of dedicated volunteers has made possible a vibrant town full of creative and passionate people. Over

a dozen new businesses have opened in the past two years, and more are on the way; vacant buildings are now the exception rather than the rule. LMS is at the center of a web of transformation, where local business doesn't just survive; it thrives.

*MERCHANT OF THE YEAR - This award recognizes one outstanding local business owner who has a flourishing and innovative business and displayed an involved commitment to downtown and his or her Main Street program.

Lott Furniture Co. is Laurel's oldest business. They have over a century of history in our small town and a plan to stick around another hundred years. The business is most certainly a family affair. Rodney's mother worked there for over 50 years, and he and Angie met at Lott when she started working there as well. The Lott team has taken Mr. Lott's original business model and adapted it for young people who are moving to Laurel, and they are dedicated to being tireless advocates for their town. "It gives us an opportunity to meet with and celebrate the local directors and investors throughout the state that are doing the hard work of making our downtown districts more competitive, successful and sustainable. We are thrilled to honor our economic development and preservation heroes in Mississippi's downtowns."

Since 1993, Mississippi Main Street Association has generated more than \$5 billion in private and public investment (including more than \$1.2 billion in public investment). In 2017, Mississippi Main Street programs generated 325 net new businesses, 95 business expansions to existing businesses, 1,458 net new jobs, 109 façade rehabilitations and 86 downtown residential units. MMSA currently has 48 active Main Street cities throughout the state, six Downtown Network members, and numerous Associate, Allied professional members, and Friends of Main


HANDBAGS and HIGH HEELS

Sylva Bay Academy host 7-on-7 tournament

Sylva Bay Academy - in coordination with Bay Springs, Raleigh, Clarkdale and Enterprise - hosted it's first 7-on-7 football tournament Tuesday morning.

"I have to give credit to Dan Brady [head football coach at Bay Springs High School]," said Sylva Bay head coach Terry Underwood. "He's the one that formed this small league we have for the month of June. Every Tuesday at 9:30 a.m. us, Raleigh, Clarkdale, Enterprise and Bay Springs all get-together and we throw a little 7-on-7."

It was Sylva Bay's turn to host the 7-on-7 tournament.

"What we do is each week we rotate it out to the different schools," Underwood said. "It was at Bay Springs last week. This week it was here at Sylva Bay. Next week we'll either be at Enterprise or Clarkdale."

Underwood said the 7-on-7 tournament is good for his program.

"The kids get to compete at a higher level," said Underwood. "I know its very beneficial for us. We get to throw and catch, and we get to see things that we work on in practice [play out]. The biggest thing is that it is great conditioning for us.

"I think this is a very positive thing. I know a lot of people do this around the state. I know when I coached at Oak Grove, we'd get together with Hattiesburg, Petal and PCS and do the same thing."

The second-year SBA coach compares it to summer league basketball.

"It's a very positive thing, and I'm glad we're able to do it," said Underwood. "It's

much like what summer league basketball is to its program."

Like some of the other teams in the tournament, Sylva-Bay Academy isn't known for its passing game. So how does it help the program?

"You get to work on throwing and catching the ball," Underwood said. "For us at Sylva Bay, we can't do that much in the regular season. We don't have enough bodies. But to line up against seven guys in the secondary, it helps us read coverage. Its great for our quarterbacks, running backs and receivers. And for our defensive personnel, it helps us get a read on the offense. It helps you improve those aspects of the game."

Sylva Bay Academy opens the 2018 season on August 17 at Tri-County Academy.





Miss. State hires new baseball coach after magic run ends in Omaha

The final chapter of the 2018 Mississippi State baseball season came to a close Saturday night in Omaha. The Bulldogs (39-29) fell to Oregon State, 5-2, in the semifinal round of the College World Series. The Beavers will now play Arkansas in a best of three series for the title.

This was Mississippi State's tenth appearance in the Col-

lege World Series, and this year's baseball team made one of the most phenomenal runs in Bulldog baseball lore. All State Mississippi



baseball teams are compared to the 1985 team that was led by future Major League All-Stars Will Clark, Rafael Palmerio, Jeff Brantley and Bobby Thigpen and one of the best college baseball coaches in Ron Polk. This 2018 team of overachievers will probably go down in history as popular as that star-studded 1985 team.

Think about this 2018 team. They lost their head coach in the first weekend of the season, but thank goodness the long haul of a 70-game season is not a short run but a marathon. So they regrouped and went forward. Besides the coaching change, these Bullies were also playing on the road much more than at home as construction was going on at Dudy Noble Field. Even with those obstacles MSU fought and clawed their way to a 15-15 SEC mark. In the postseason, these Bulldogs won a Tallahassee and Nashville Super Regional with walk-offs in both locations. They won 11 times in their final at-bat this season. They even carried that magic over to Omaha by beating Washington, 1-0, on the first day in their final at-bat of the CWS. MSU trailed in four of its eight wins in the NCAA Tournament and made comebacks in 21 of its 39 wins this season. This team, propelled by junior outfielder Jake Mangum and the good luck rally banana charm caught the attention of the college baseball world.

Early Monday morning, MSU announced the hiring of Chris Lemonis to take over as the Bulldogs' baseball skipper for next season. Lemonis comes to Starkville from Indiana, where he had a good run for four seasons. Before taking his first head coaching job at Indiana, Lemonis coached under Dan McDonnell at Louisville and helped the Cardinals reach the College World Series three times in eight seasons. At least one baseball publication rates him as the nation's top college baseball recruiter, and he was in charge of McDonnell's recruiting at Louisville. The Hoosiers went 40-19 under Lemonis this spring. Lemonis will replace interim Head Coach Gary Henderson.

New Orleans Saints

The Saints after three straight so-so seasons rebounded to an 11-5 mark due to an influx of a great 2017 draft class. Led by Offensive Rookie of the Year Alvin Kamara and Defensive Rookie of the Year Marshon Lattimore and the old master Drew Brees, the Saints almost made it to the NFC Championship game. The Saints' offense is one of the best in the league, but last year's offense added a running game that actually helped the defense improve. The defense went from 30th to 10th overall and that improvement led to the threewin improvement from the previous sea-

The Saints will have to get off to a strong start as they face Tampa Bay in




