

Gone Fishing!

You might not think of seafood as seasonal. If you go to the supermarket, many types of fish are available year-round. But not all seafood is created equal. If you care about fresh seafood, sustainable fisheries, protecting our oceans and eating fish that is healthier for you and your family, it pays to know what fish are in season. Here are some season. Here are some great tips about selecting fish from the Center for Food Safety, www. centerforfoodsafety.org.

Five Tips to Choosing
Sustainable Seafood:

1. Choose local seafood if possible, and always choose domestic over imported. 2. Choose wild.

3. If it's farmed, choose seafood from the U.S., especially in low- or

no-output, recirculating systems.

4. Favor fish caught by hook and line, handline, troll (not to be confused with "trawl" fishing, which can be very destructive), jig or speargun.
5. Avoid fish that are high in mercu-

Much of the fish available today in the United States is imported, and frequently from places where health

and environmental standards are weak and environmental standards are weak or non-existent. Worldwide, regulation of the fishing industry is poorly enforced, and less than 2 percent of seafood imports to the U.S. are inspected for contamination.



Shipping fish around the world has a negative impact on the climate, but it can have an even greater impact on our oceans. With nearly 85 percent of the world's fisheries overfished, our seafood choices are more important than ever. Decades of overfishing have driven many fish populations to levels so low that recovery is a long-term proposition.

Farm raised or wild-caught?
Aquaculture, the farming of fish and seafood, has resulted in a far-reachseafood, has resulted in a far-reaching variety of environmental consequences, including the escape of farmed fish from their containment that threatens native wild fish populations; the spread of deadly diseases and parasites; and the pollution of our oceans from the inputs and outputs of fish farming. Though presented by the industry as a "solution" to over-fish-industry as a "solution" to over-fishindustry as a "solution" to over-fishing, the overwhelming evidence is that aquaculture is not relieving any pressures on wild fisheries.

Studies also have found farmed fish to be less healthful than their wild counterparts. Fish farms frequently use antibiotics to control disease in their crowded pens, and PCBs accumulate in farmed fish at a higher associated with increased risk of can-

associated with increased risk of can-cer, disrupting the endocrine system, and contributing to developmental and reproductive problems. Eating seasonally — whether it's fruits, vegetables or fish — is a healthier choice for both our plates and our planet. Use the tips above to go fishing this summer in your grocer's seafood department and try this wonderful recipe for wild Alaska this wonderful recipe for wild Alaska

HERB-ROASTED WILD ALASKA SALMON

(2- to 2 1/2-pound) skinless wild Alaska salmon fillet teaspoon coarse sea salt teaspoon freshly ground

black pepper teaspoon cayenne pepper cup extra-virgin olive oil tablespoons fresh lemon juice

teaspoon lemon zest minced whole green onions, green tops and white parts cup minced fresh dill

cup minced fresh parsley cup dry white wine, chicken or vegetable stock

Lemon wedges Heat oven to 425 F.

2. Place the salmon in a ceramic glass or stainless-steel roasting dish and season with salt, black and cay-enne pepper. Whisk the olive oil and lemon juice together and drizzle over the salmon. Let sit at room temperature for 15 minutes.

3. In a small bowl, stir together the

lemon zest, scallions, dill and parsley Scatter the herbs over the salmon turning it so that both sides are coat-ed. Pour the wine or broth around the fish fillet in the roasting dish.

4. Roast the salmon for 10 to 12 minutes, until firm and almost cooked in the center. Cover the dish tightly with aluminum foil and allow to rest for 10 minutes. Cut the salmon crosswise into serving pieces, and se hot with lemon wedges. Serves 6.

Cookie Baking Tips

—To prevent cookies from becoming hard and tough, avoid adding more flour than necessary to the cookie dough or batter. Also, avoid overmixing once the flour is added.

—For even baking, be sure to shape cookies to roughly the same thickness.

—If you have a problem with

—If you have a problem with your cookies being too brown on the bottom, avoid dark-colored cookie sheets. Instead, use heavy-gauge metal cookie sheets with a dull finish (aluminum is ideal).

—To avoid burning your cookies, check cookies at the minimum baking time suggested in the recipe, and then watch them closely during their last few minutes in the oven. Also, after baking be sure to remove small cookies from cookie sheet to wire rack right away because they'll continue to bake on the hot sheet.

—Don't place cookies on top of each other when cooling — this will cause them to become soggy and lose their shape.

—Do your cookies turn hard the next day? Placing a slice of bread in the cookie jar can soften cookies; change the slice every other day. A bread slice also will also keep soft cookies soft, just as it softens hardened brown sugar.

Shell-Shaped Watch Holder

Shell-shaped decorative objects were very popular during the 19th century. There were trinket boxes covered in tiny shells, counter bells made with several mother-of-pearl shells put together into a container, or nautilus shells used as part of cleverly shaped lamps that held a special light bulb. Some large conch shells were kept whole as decorations, often with the addition of a cameo carved into

part of the shell. Glassmakers adapted the shell shape to their medium, and during the late 1800s, many "shells" were made of colored glass that was decorated with enamel paint or held in elaborate metal frames

A shell-shaped cranberry glass watch holder with enameled decorations was auctioned recently. The almost egg-shaped glass was held in a gilt metal frame with leaves, flowers and a bird finial. The unusual piece, probably American, sold for \$708 at a Conestoga auction in Pennsylvania. It was lined with padded fabric to protect the watch. A pocket watch kept in a holder on a table near the bed served as a bedroom clock







The Ins And Outs Of Safe Outdoor Cooking

(NAPSA)—Your next barbecue may be better if you follow these 10 tips from the experts at the United States Department of Agriculture on keeping food safe when cooking outside:

1. When shopping, buy meat and poultry last. Choose packages that feel cold and are not torn. Separate raw meat and poultry from other food in your shopping cart to guard against cross-contamination. Plan to go directly home from the grocery store. 2. At home, freeze or refrigerate

meat and poultry immediately. Freeze poultry and ground meat that won't be used in a day or two; freeze other meat within four or

five days.

3. Completely thaw meat and poultry before grilling so it cooks evenly. Use the refrigerator for slow, safe thawing or thaw sealed packages in cold water. You can microwave defrost if the food will be placed immediately on the grill.

4. Keep meat and poultry cold until you're ready to put it on the grill. If you're carrying food to another location, keep it in an insulated cooler with sufficient ice or ice packs so it stays at 40° F or below. Keep the cooler out of the direct sun and avoid opening the lid too often.

5. Start with clean hands— wash them for at least 20 seconds with warm, soapy water—and a clean grill and utensils.

6. Be sure the grill is hot enough to safely cook your food. 7. Remember, meat and poultry

cooked on a grill often brown very fast on the outside. Use a thermometer to be sure the food has reached a safe minimum internal temperature—poultry: 165° F; ground meats: 160° F; beef, pork, lamb and veal, steaks, chops and roasts: 145° F—and allow to rest



promptly in shallow containers. Discard any food left out more than two hours (one hour if temperatures are above 90° F). Bacteria can grow rapidly between 40° and 140° F. Learn More







Was Son Right to Ignore His Doctor's Advice?

DEAR DR. ROACH: My son is 40 years old. After a recent stress test, he ended up with five stents in his arteries, and also was diagnosed with diabetes. His doctor ordered him not to go back to work for three nim not to go back to work for three or four weeks, but he went back after three days. He told the doctor that he would be more stressed if he stayed home. His job is mostly sitting down. Since he didn't follow the advice, how will this affect his health? — V.B. ANSWER: We don't normally have

people stay home for long periods of time after placement of stents, so I was surprised to hear that he was "ordered" (I almost never "order," only recommend, more or less strongly) to stay home.

My experience is that after receiving life-changing diagnoses, such as diabetes or coronary artery disease, it's best to keep some habits, such as work, the same and change others. For your son, I am sure he will be recommended a proper diet for diabetes and exercise appropriate for a person with a new diagnosis of heart disease.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I've suffered from essential tremor for 16 years. I take 500 mg of primidone and 40 mg of propranolol twice daily. I've gradually increased the dose over the years, and the combination works quite well. What is the highest dose of these medications that I can take? Also, are there any new

drugs on the market that have been proven to help? — S.S.

ANSWER: Primidone, a medica-tion indicated for seizures, often is used off-label for essential tremor. The normal dose for essential tremor The normal dose for essential tremor is 250-500 mg at night, but doses up to 750 mg sometimes are used. For seizures, the highest recommended dose is 2,000 mg, so although yours is at the high end of normal for essential tremor ("essential," by the way, simply means we don't know what is causing it; it isn't essential for anything), you still are at a dose that's well below the safe limit. I suspect that because you have been on it for so long, your body have been on it for so long, your body is used to this dose. The usual starting dose is 25 mg. Propranolol is used for many conditions, including high blood pres-

sure and preventing migraines, but its use in essential tremor also is off-label, meaning that the Food and Drug Administration has not approved the drug for use for this condition. "Off-label" doesn't necessarily mean your prescription is wrong or danger-ous, only that it hasn't been approved by the FDA. In your case, the combi-nation of primidone and propranolol frequently is used and recommended in the medical literature. For essential tremor, experts have recommended doses up to 320 mg per day, but the dose can be limited by slow heart rate or low blood pressure.

If you are doing well, there is no reason to change. Other medications frequently used for essential tremor include gabapentin and topiramate. There also are surgical treatments, deep brain stimulation, gamma knife radiation of the product of the state tion and ultrasound for resistant cases



Chewy Chocolate Chip Oatmeal-Raisin Cookies

If you thought the words "delicious" and "low-fat" could never be used to describe one cookie, think again. This one's chewy, sweet and chock-full of chocolate bits, yet it still packs only 2 grams of fat per serving.

Nonstick cooking spray cup (1 stick) light corn-oil spread (56 to 60 percent fat)

cup packed dark brown sugar 1/2 cup sugar

large egg whites

large egg teaspoons vanilla extract

cups all-purpose flour cup quick-cooking oats

cup low-fat semisweet-

chocolate pieces cup dark seedless raisins

teaspoon baking soda teaspoon salt

1. Heat oven to 375 F. Spray 2 large cookie sheets with nonstick cooking

2. In large bowl, with mixer at low speed, beat corn-oil spread, brown sugar and sugar until combined. Increase speed to high; beat until light and fluffy.

3. Add egg whites, egg and vanilla extract; beat until smooth.

4. With spoon, stir in flour, oats, chocolate pieces, raisins, baking soda and salt until combined.

5. Drop dough by level tablespoons, about 2 inches apart, on cookie sheets. Place cookie sheets on 2 oven racks. Bake cookies 10 to 12 minutes until golden, rotating cookie sheets between upper and lower racks halfway through baking time. With pancake turner, remove cookies to wire racks to cool.

6. Repeat until all batter is used. Store cookies in tightly covered con-





Pacific Rim: Uprising (PG-13) — It's the next generation's turn to throw giant robots at otherworldly monsters in the sequel to Guillermo del Toro's inventive 2013 original. This is no shiny new penny, though: The Jaegers (human-controlled giant robot-type vehicles) are still battling the Kaijus (also giant alien-controlled monsters that threaten the existence of all life on Earth). John Boyega stars as Jake Pentecost, son of Stacker Pentecost, from the original. A jaded former pilot turned fringe jaded former pilot turned fringe criminal, he is pressed into serving as a trainer and bringing along a ragtag recruit: the scrappy hacker Amara (Cailee Spaeny). As new threats emerge, it's down to Jake, Amara and Jake's former co-pilot Nate Lambert (Scott Eastwood) to stop the re-emergent threat of the Kaiju. Unsane (R) — It's a new job in a new city for Sawyer Valentini (Claire Foy), whose previous life involved a troubling stalker named David (Joshua Leonard). She's doing all the right things to recover, including joining a local support group. An orderly is revealed as her former stalker, and as the body count rises, reality becomes skewed.
